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PROCEEDING OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Temporary appointment of 7 employees of the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre, Mysore in the services of the Karnataka Welfare of Disabled Services.

PREAMBLE:

The Union of India launched a scheme for Rehabilitation of the disabled people with the financial assistance of Government of India as a pilot project in selected places all over the country by establishing District Rehabilitation Centres and in Karnataka in T.Narasipur taluk of the Mysore District in 1983. The scheme was implemented through the State of Karnataka as per Government Order No.SWL 7 PHP 83 dated 13-09-1983. (The project coordinator of the Rehabilitation Centre was the officer of the State Government, who selected the employees for the Rehabilitation Centres. Terms and conditions of services of the employees appointed including payscales were governed by the rules applicable to the employees of the State Governments.)

In 2005, Government of India informed the State Government to take over the said project with effect from 2006-07 as it is not in a position to provide grants and that the staff of the District Rehabilitation Centre are paid the scales of pay of the State Government. The employees of the District Rehabilitation Centre were not appointed in accordance with the rules framed by the State Government and their salary was borne by the Central Government. State Government expressed its inability to take over the said project and also the employees of the project. The project has been wound up from 1-04-2006.

The following officials working in the said project filed Original Application before the Central Administrative Tribunal praying for a direction to the Government of India to treat them as employees of the Central Government and to apply to them the service conditions applicable to the employees of the Central Government:

The Application filed by the aforesaid was allowed on 5-8-2002 directing to treat the aforesaid as employees of Central Government and grant them all the reliefs that they are entitled. Aggrieved by the said order, the Union of India filed Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka which was disposed of on 27-1-2003 rejecting the petitions. Against the said order, the Civil Appeal No. 4313/2003 filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court was disposed of on 10-11-2006 with the directions, the relevant portion of which is extracted as hereunder:

"In a case of this nature however, we think it expedient to invoke our jurisdiction under Article 142 of the Constitution of India. The Central Government has categorically stated that those employees who would opt for employment under the Central Government may be accommodated in its ongoing projects. Pursuant thereto or in furtherance thereof, the concerned employees who have affirmed affidavits showing inclination to serve any project under the Central Government, may be absorbed by it. Services of those employees may be utilized by the Central Government in any of its project. They would, however, be continued to be paid salaries on the same scale of pay. Their experience may also be considered for the purpose of determination of their seniority, subject of course to any rule which is in operation in the field. All other financial benefits including those of superannuation benefits should be protected. It is, however, clarified that such employment under the Central Government would be temporary and personal posts which would come to an end with the retirement of the concerned employees.

Similarly those Respondents who have opted for their employment with the State of West Bengal or the State of Karnataka, as the case may be would be absorbed by the States of West Bengal and Karnataka, as the case may be, on the same terms and conditions as referred to hereinbefore."

Smt. T.S.Sunanthi, one of the respondents has sworn to an Affidavit on 21-9-2006 affirming that she is willing to work in any project establishment of the Government of India with all service benefits entitled to Government of India Employees with effect from the Date of appointment. However, Sri G.Mariappan, has sworn to affidavit on 26-9-2006, the relevant portion of which is extracted as hereunder:

"1. That I am the Respondent No.4 in the above Civil Appeal as such I know the facts and circumstances of the case. I am also authorized to swear to this Affidavit on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 7. This affidavit is filed as per the directions of this Hon'ble Court dated 26.09.2006.

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That it is humbly submitted that the contesting Respondents are willing to work in the present project, if the project is taken over or directed to be taken over by the State of Karnataka or any other similar project and department of the Karnataka State Government."

Pursuant to the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the Affidavit filed by the contesting Respondent, the appointment of the respondents in the services of the State Government was under process in consultation with the other wings of the Government. During the process, the Orders passed by the Constitutional Bench of this Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.3595/3612/1999 disposed of on 10-4-2006 regarding regularization of the employees observing that "We also clarify that regularization, if any already made, but not subjudice, need not be reopened based on this judgment, but there should be no further by-passing of the constitutional requirement and regularizing or making permanent, those duly appointed as per the Constitutional Scheme"

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has in Civil Appeal No.4313/2003 directed that Services of those employees may be utilized by the Central Government/State Government, as the case may be, in any of its projects, Government has already taken a decision not to take over the District Rehabilitation Centre and the employees in question have affirmed in the affidavit imposing a condition that they are willing to work in the present project, if the project is taken over or directed to be taken over by the State of Karnataka or any other similar project and department of the Karnataka State Government, but no similar project existed.

In spite of the conditional Affidavit, however, the question of appointing them temporarily in the Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services have been examined. The Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2004 issued under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 is in force. The said services do not contain category of posts of Prosthetic and Orthotic Engineer, Orthotist and Prosthetist Therapist and Leather Worker/Shoe Maker held by four employees and the said rules did not permit making temporary appointment of project employees in Government service.

Similarly, the following 14 persons appointed temporarily in the aforesaid project were found to be surplus due to revision of the scheme and reduction of posts:

Among the aforesaid Smt. A. Gayathri Devi and Sri Prabhakar were discharged at the end of the temporary tenure and their applications filed before the Karnataka Administrative Tribunal were dismissed on 25-11-1994. Apprehending discharge from service at the end of the temporary tenure, other 14 official also filed Application Nos.1100/1991 before the Karnataka Administrative Tribunal which were allowed on 9-02-1995 directing the State Government not to relieve the said officials until their appointment or absorption in service and also extending the similar relief to Smt. A. Gayathri Devi and Sri Prabhakar allowing their review application. The appeal filed by the State Government against the said order was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP/97 CC 6643 on 03-09-1997.

The Petitioners in Civil Appeal No.4313-4319/2003 disposed of on 10-11-2006 have now filed Contempt Petition No.173-179/2007 and notices have been issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Keeping in view, the directions of the Hon'ble Court, in Civil Appeal No.4313-4319/2003 disposed of on 10-11-2006 and also the dismissal of the appeal of the State

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Government No. SEP/97/11643 dt. 03/09/1997, the following orders are issued in respect of the complained as also officer, arrested 14 employees of the District Rehabilitation Centre, Mysore who are similarly circumstances

ORDER No. WCD 178 PHP 2004

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub. Temporary appointment of 7 employees of the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre, Mysore in the services of The Karnataka Welfare of Disabled Services, Modification of conditions of service.

Read: Order No.WCD 178 PHP 2004 dated 16-11-2007.

PREAMBLE:

The Union of India launched a scheme for Rehabilitation of the disabled people with the financial assistance of Government of India as a pilot project in selected places all over the country by establishing District Rehabilitation Centres and in Karnataka in T.Narasipur taluk of the Mysore District in 1983. The scheme was implemented through the State of Karnataka as per Government Order No:SWL.7.PHP 83 dated 13-09-1983. The Project Coordinator of the Rehabilitation Centre was the Officer of the State Government, who selected the employees for the Rehabilitation Centres. Terms and conditions of services of the employees appointed including pay scales were governed by the rules applicable to the employees of the State Governments.

In 2005, Government of India informed the State Government to take over the said project with effect from 2006-07 as it is not in a position to provide grants and that the staff of the District Rehabilitation Centre is paid the scales of pay of the State Government. The employees of the District Rehabilitation Centre were not appointed in accordance with the rules framed by the State Government and their salary was borne by the Central Government. State Government expressed its inability to take over the said project and also the employees of the project. The project has been wound up from 01-04-2006.

The following officials working in the said project files Original Application before the Central Administrative Tribunal praying for a direction to the Government of India to treat them as employees of the Central Government and to apply to them the service conditions applicable to the employees of the Central Government:

The application filed by the aforesaid was allowed on 5-8-2002 directing to treat the aforesaid employees of Central Government and grant them all the relief that they are entitled. Aggrieved by the said order, the Union of India filed Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka which was disposed of on 27-1-2003 rejecting the petitions. Against the said order, the Civil Appeal No.4313 2003 filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court was disposed of on 10-11-2006 with the directions, the relevant portion of which is extracted as hereunder.

"In a case of this nature however, we think it expedient to invoke our jurisdiction under Article 142 of the Constitution of India. The Central Government has categorically stated that those employees who would opt for employment under the Central Government may be accommodated in its ongoing projects. Pursuant thereto or in furtherance thereof, the concerned employees who have affirmed affidavits showing inclination to serve any project under the Central Government may be absorbed by it. Services of those employees may be utilized by the Central Government in any of its project. They would, however, be continued to be paid salaries on the same scale of pay. Their experience may also be considered for the purpose of determination of the seniority, subject of course to any rule, which is in operation in the field. All other financial benefits including those of superannatory benefits should be protected. It is, however, clarified that such employment under the Central Government would be temporary and personal posts, which would come to an end with the retirement of the concerned employees.

Similarly those Respondents who have opted for their employment with the State of West Bengal or the State of Karnataka, as the case may be would be absorbed by the States of West Bengal and Karnataka, as the case may be, on the same terms and conditions as referred to hereinbefore."

IN compliance to the directions contained in the aforesaid judgment, and in accordance with the option exercised by the aforesaid respondents in the affidavits filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in the order read above, Sriyuths (1) G.Mariappan, Prosthetic and Orthotic Engineer (2) R.V.Kulakarni, Orthotist and Prosthetist (3) T.F.Zaidi, Therapist (4) V.Chandra, Leather Worker/Shoe Maker (5) Smt.I.S.Sunanthi, Stenographer (6) M.Sureshkumar, Messenger (Peon) and (7) Palani.

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Sweepers who were employed in the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre, Mysore are continued temporarily in the posts of Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services in the posts of District Disabled Welfare officer, Superintendent (Non Gazetted), (2), Second Division Assistant, Stenographer and Group-D posts (2) respectively. The order dated 16.11.2007, inter alia, provided for protection of the pay drawn in the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre with monetary benefits with effect from 01-04-2006 besides providing counting their past services for purposes of pay.

The order passed by the State Government had come up before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition 173-179 2007 and having perused the order dated 16.11.2007 of the Government the Hon'ble Court expressed its dissatisfaction about the compliance of its order passed in the Civil Appeals.

The Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services (Recruitment Rules 2004 issued under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act 1978 constituting Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services do not have posts with scale of pay similar to the posts held by the aforesaid 7 employees and do not provide for absorption of the said employees as a mode of recruitment. Hence it is necessary to create supernumerary posts to accommodate the said employees to continue in the services of the Government by framing Special rules to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India under Article 142 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the urgency, pending framing of special rules in this behalf, it is considered necessary to modify the order as far as the aforesaid 7 employees are concerned and accordingly the following orders are issued.

After examining all aspects of the matter, Government of Karnataka in continuation and partial modification of the Government Order dated 16.11.2007 read above, hereby accords sanction for creation of the following posts in the scales of pay indicated against them with effect from 01-04-2006 in the Karnataka Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen Services of the Department of Disabled and Welfare of Senior Citizens and the under mentioned employees of the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre, Mysore are absorbed in the said services till their Superannuation.

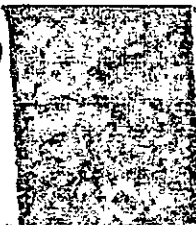
(2) The services rendered by them in the erstwhile District Rehabilitation Centre until the date of their appointment herein shall count for purpose of increment and pension:-

*Provided that the services rendered by them on or after the date of their appointment herein shall count for purpose of determination of seniority of such person with reference to persons who are appointed to such category of posts.

4. The Director, Department of Disabled and Welfare of Senior Citizens shall prescribe such work commensurate with the qualifications of the employees and may post them along with the Supernumerary posts created wherever necessary.

5. The Karnataka Civil Services Rules, the Karnataka Civil Service (Conduct) Rules 1966 and all other rules for the time being in force regulating the conditions of service of Government Servants made under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978, in so far as such rules are not inconsistent with the terms of appointment herein shall be applicable.


