Oppn to press for repeal of farm laws in Parl

NEW DELHI: The government on Sunday said Parliament will first take up discussions on the Motion of Thanks to the address of President Ram Nath Kovind to the joint sitting of the two Houses. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Prahlad Joshi said the Opposition can raise important issues in the second half of the Budget session.

The first half of the session

is set to conclude on February 13 instead of the scheduled February 15, and the second half will commence from March 9 and conclude on April 8.

Joshi said the government is ready to answer any questions of the Opposition. The Opposition is bracing up to corner the government on the contentious farm laws, making their intent clear during the all-party meet-

ing chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday.

The NDA floor managers are gearing up to the prospects of the Opposition insisting on the two Houses taking up the adjournment motions to repeal the contentious farm laws right after the presentation of the Budget on Monday. There will be restricted media presence to cover the proceedings. ENS
