Relocating Nehru statue referred to privileges panel

BENGALURU, DHNS: Following a delay on part of the government in relocating the statue of former PM Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on the Vidhana Soudha premises, Council chairperson Pratapchandra Shetty on Tuesday directed the matter to be referred to the Privileges Committee of the House.

On September 23, 2020, after a ruckus erupted in the Council with Congress leaders demanding relocation of the statue, Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa had given a written statement that the statue would be relocated at the earliest.

On Tuesday, member K Govindaraj pointed out that even though the then chief secretary had directed the officials concerned to relocate it by December 31, 2020, no action was taken.

"This is a breach of privilege. I urge this matter to be referred to the Privileges Committee," he submitted in the House.

Giving his approval to this, Shetty said, not only will this be referred to the committee, action will be initiated against those who did not properly record the proceedings in the House on the said day.
