## 'Big explosion' if CM is not changed: Yatnal

He tells Arun Singh to stop praising BSY

Basanagouda Patil Yatnal, Vijayapura MLA, has said that there will be a "big explosion" in the State if Chief Minister B.S. Yediyurappa is not removed before May 2.

Reacting to RDPR Minister K.S. Eshwarappa writing to the Governor complaining against the alleged "interference" by the Chief Minister, Mr. Yatnal said it was bound to happen. "Mr. Eshwarappa suffered silently all these days and now he has been forced to go to the Governor," Mr. Yatnal said.
