## Former Bhadravathi MLA Appaji Gowda dies (1) (2) (2) of Covid

BHADRAVATHI/KOLAR/KAL-ABURAGI, DHN5: JD(S) leader and former Bhadravathi MLA M J Appaji Gowda died of Covid-19 at the District Mc-Gann Hospital in Shivamogga late on Wednesday night. He was 67.

He had worked at Visvesvaraya Iron and Steel plant before taking a plunge into electoral politics. Appaji Gowda made his Assembly debut in 1994 elections from Bhadravathi as Independent. He defeated his arch rival B K Sangamesh in 1999 and bagged a hat-trick of wins in 2013 elections, defeating C M Ibrahim of Congress.
