New Delhi: In a key reform that seeks to bring a paradigm shift in human resource management of the civil services, the Union Cabinet on Wednesday cleared 'Mission Karmayogi' that will upgrade the knowledge and skills of civil servants on a continuous basis with the aid of modern technology and ensure that the right man with the right competencies is in the right position in government.
