## SC judge, others heap praise on 'most loved' PM

Prime Minister Narendra Modi was on Saturday hailed as a "visionary" and the "most popular and loved" leader in the country by a sitting judge of the Supreme Court.

The Chief Justice of the Gujarat High Court and several other senior judicial officers also praised Modi during a virtual event celebrating the diamond jubilee of the Gujarat High Court, where the PM released a postal stamp.

"Ifeel proud and privileged to participate in the release of the commemorative stamp, that too by our most popular, loved, vibrant and visionary leader, honourable Prime Minister Narendabhai Modi," said Supreme Court judge Mukesh R Shah.

Justice Shah was a judge in the high court, who was elevat-

ed to the Patna High Court as chief justice before being promoted to the SC in 2018.

He wound up his speech quickly "as we have to hear and listen to our most loved PM".
