Council ruckus: Panel formed against rules, says Ayanur

Urges chair to refer the incident to a House Committee

Senior BJP MLC Ayanur Manjunath has charged that the special House committee formed to look into the December 15 ruckus in the Upper House was against the rules.

Manjunath contended that making Congress MLC B K Hariprasad a member of the committee was questionable as he was one of the "key orchestrators of the attack on the Deputy Chairman".

In a letter to Legislative Council chairperson K Prataphchandra Shetty, Manjunath noted that the chair was empowered to take any measures to maintain the discipline of the Council.

However, with respect to the issues such as the December 15 incident, any committee formed to investigate it should be formed in consultation with all members of the Council, he said.

The chairperson, Manjunath said, should recommend the incident to the Rules Committee than forming a House Committee for the purpose. Objecting to the appointment of Marithibbegowda as the head of the House Committee, he said that the MLC had openly backed the Congress and the appointment reflected some bias.

"The intention of appointing B K Hariprasad, one of the key orchestrators in provoking other members to attack the deputy chairman of the House, to the committee is questionable," he said.

He urged the chairperson to withdraw the 'illegally' formed House Committee and recommended that the issue be handed over to the Rules Committee.
