Supplementary estimates

Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa on Tuesday tabled supplementary estimates aggregating Rs 3,320.40 crore for the 2020-21 financial year in the Legislative Assembly. This includes expenditure incurred on flood relief, Covid-19 and others. Supplementary estimates are additional expenditures incurred by the government over and above the budget provision for the financial year. The government has also shown Rs 7 crore as expenditure for the Rajarajeshwari and Sira bypolls.

Two Bills tabled

The government on Tuesday tabled the Karnataka Stamp (Second) Amendment Bill, 2020, in the Assembly to cut stamp duty from 5% to 2% for apartments costing less than Rs 20 lakh. Flats costing between Rs 20-35 lakh will be levied 3% stamp duty, the Bill proposes. It further proposes to "reduce or remit" stamp duty for new or existing MSMEs and Large, Mega, Super Mega and Ultra Mega enterprises. The government also tabled the Karnataka Parliamentary Secretaries Salary, Allowances, and Miscellaneous Provisions (Repeal) Bill, 2020, after the High Court struck down the validity of the posts of parliamentary secretaries.
