Bengaluru: Between the farmers' protest and Rule 69, the former won. Speaker Vishweshwar Hegde Kageri, who had allowed time for taking up issues under Rule 69, after Question Hour, was none too happy to see empty benches. As the session progressed, it became evident that Opposition legislators preferred to join the action outside. The Speaker expressed displeasure that legislators who had sought information were themselves absent.
