BJP MP issues breach of privilege notice against Mahua Moitra

Former Union Minister and Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) MP P.P. Chaudhary on Wednesday issued a breach of privilege notice against Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra in the Lok Sabha for the her remarks against a former Chief Justice of India.

"While speaking on the

Motion of Thanks on the President's address, she has cast some aspersions with respect to the conduct of a judge. So the question is whether the conduct of a judge can be discussed on the floor of the House or not," Mr. Chaudhary said, adding that Article 121 of the Constitution does not allow allegations to be levelled

against a sitting or a former judge.

Supporting him, BJP MP Nishikant Dubey demanded that Ms. Moitra's membership be cancelled.

Revolutionary Socialist Party (RSP) MP N. K. Premachandran, who was in the Chair, said that the notice was under the consideration of the Lok Sabha Speaker.
