Speaker asks MPs to stop disturbing LS proceedings

New Delhi: Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla on Wednesday ticked off Lok Sabha MPs on both sides for their tendency to chat with one another when proceedings of the House are on, calling it unacceptable. Birla also told members to go to the gallery, "which is just two steps away", if they wanted to talk to other members.

"I have seen the tendency of some members of talking to each other while sitting in their seats as well as while standing. This is your House. If you want to run this House like that way, I can do that. But is that correct?" he asked.

Birla, who has also reprimanded MPs cutting across parties for speaking out of turn or while remaining seated, said, "I will not allow anyone to talk while sitting in the House and while standing. The gallery is just two steps away. If you want to talk, go to the gallery," he said.
