**Govt considers
council panel
null and void**

Bengaluru: The house committee formed by legislative council chairman Prathap Chandra Shetty to probe the ruckus on December 15 has been dismissed by the government as "null and void" following the resignation of BJP members on the panel.

Law and parliamentary affairs minister JC Madhuswamy on Monday said the government will not take cognisance of any report submitted by the committee sans members from the BJP. This follows two BJP legislators, AH Vishwanath and SV Sankanur, resigning from the committee even before its first sitting.

Despite the statement, opposition Congress decided to continue with its fact-finding mission and said it'll submit the report within 20 days.

Congress MLC PR Ramesh, citing Supreme Court rulings, said the committee had been set up as per rules of the legislative council and alleged the BJP is scared to face the truth. Committee chairperson Marithibbe Gowda said it'll continue with its work as the resignation of two BJP legislators did not have any bearing on the committee which has a quorum with three members which include himself and MLCs BK Hari-prasad and RB Thimmarpur.
