Farmers move SC over agri laws

NEW DELHI, DHNS

The Bhartiya Kisan Union Bhanu, a farmers union, has approached the Supreme Court challenging the validity of the three farm laws enacted recently by the Modi government.

Farmers' union president Bhanu Pratap Singh filed an intervention application in the PIL filed by DMK MP Tiruchi Siva against the three contentious laws, which have triggered massive protests along Delhi's borders.

The plea claimed if the present laws were allowed to continue, corporates can "export our agriculture produce without any regulation, and may even result in famines".

Maintaining that these laws were illegal and arbitrary, the union claimed they would pave the way for cartelisation and commercialisation of agricultural produce.

farm laws will make farmers' position vulnerable to corporate greed of multinational companies.

"These laws would dismantle the APMC system intended to ensure fair prices for farm products," it claimed, adding that these laws were passed in haste.
