Cong MLCs seek Guv's intervention in Council affairs

BENGALURU, DHNS: A group of Congress MLCs has sought Governor Vajubhai Vala's intervention in withholding assent to the anti-cow slaughter Bill and a "review" of the manner in which senior JD(S) leader Basavaraj Horatti was elected Legislative Council chairperson.

The Congress MLCs have sought action against Deputy Chairperson M K Pranesh for taking up the anti-cow slaughter Bill for passage "even though the entire Opposition members demanded for the division (of votes) and we all rushed to the well of the House," they said in their petition to Vala.

Also, the MLCs have point-

ed out that the manner in which Horatti was declared elected as the chairperson was flawed. They said the House was not in order during the process.

"The Deputy Chairman failed to bring the House in order and declared Mr Basavaraj Horatti as Chairman of the House by considering only motion moved by JD(S) members without conducting the election, contrary to the rules of procedure and conduct of business (sic)," they said in the petition, adding that Congress MLC Naseer Ahmed had filed his nomination as a contestant for the chairperson's position.
