**Ex-mayor gets
bail in riots case**

Bengaluru: The high court on Friday granted conditional bail to ex-mayor Sampath Raj, an accused in the August 11 east Bengaluru violence.

Allowing Raj's plea, Justice John Michael Cunha said the petitioner has to cooperate in the ongoing trial, not tamper with witnesses and also not leave Bengaluru without the trial court's permission.

The judge indicated that in case the petitioner violates any of the conditions imposed, the Central Crime Branch is free to move the court seeking cancellation of his bail. Raj is the third accused in the case to have been granted bail. Last week, former corporator Rakeeb Zakir and another accused Jameel got the same. TNN
