Will not implement CAA in Kerala, ¹⁴¹²⁻¹²⁴ reiterates CM Vijayan

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, DHNS: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Saturday said that his government would not implement the controversial Citizenship (Amendment) Act (CAA).

Inaugurating a statewide march of the Left Democratic Front in Kasaragod ahead of the Assembly elections, Vijayan said that there were some announcements that the CAA would be implemented after Covid-19 vaccination drive ends. "Kerala has already clarified that CAA will not be implemented and there was no change in it," the chief minister reiterated.
