Police register FIR in sleaze CD case

BENGALURU, DHNS ...

olice on Saturday registered an FIR in the sex CD case after former minister Ramesh Jarkiholi sought a probe into the creators and conspirators behind the "fake CD".

Hours later, the case saw another twist as a video clip surfaced, in which a woman claimed that Jarkiholi promised her a job and also got videos released, bringing her shame and pushing her to kill herself.

According to Sadashivanagarpolice, former NelamangalaMLA Nagaraju approached them with a complaint copy signed by Jarkiholi following which an FIR was registered against unknown persons behind the CD scandal.

In the FIR, the complainant alleged a conspiracy, claiming that a "fake CD" was created and released to the activist and on social media.

"To humiliate me politically, finish my political career and to extort money, unknown persons have made conspiracy,"

the complaint stated.

"For three months, they plotted and made a fake CD cheating me, harassing me mentally, to politically defame and tried to extort money from me."

According to the complaint, "many people are involved in it". "A few conspired, a few made fake videos. They used others and uploaded them on social media and made me politically unstable. So take necessary action against them," it states. Later, speaking to reporters, Jarkiholi said he will not drop the case until it was solved but refused to comment on the new clip.

"I am not the lone victim here. This can happen to anyone. Everyone should fight against it together," he said, urging not to encourage such "blackmail tactics".
