Sampath Raj ex-mayor Sampath Raj and and Zakir hatched a plan to provoke the crowd to go to the MLA's house. The crowd later set fire to the house. "On the instruction of Sampath Raj, his personnel assistant, car driver and Zakir's associate Majnu conspired and provoked the mob," police said.
