India records 2.16 lakh new cases, 1,153 deaths

Maharashtra leads with 61,695 cases, followed by U.P.

India registered 2,16,642 new COVID-19 cases and 1,153 deaths as of 11.15 p.m. on Thursday.

The country has so far reported a total of 1,42,87,740 cases and 1,74,306 deaths.

The figures do not include cases and deaths from Ladakh and Tripura. The data are sourced from *covid19india.org*, an independent aggregator of daily figures.

Over 13.84 lakh tests were conducted on Wednesday.

Maharashtra reported 61,695 infections, accounting for nearly 31% of the new cases, followed by Uttar Pradesh (22,339) and Delhi (16,699). Maharashtra also recorded 349 casualties, followed by Delhi (112) and Chhattisgarh (105).

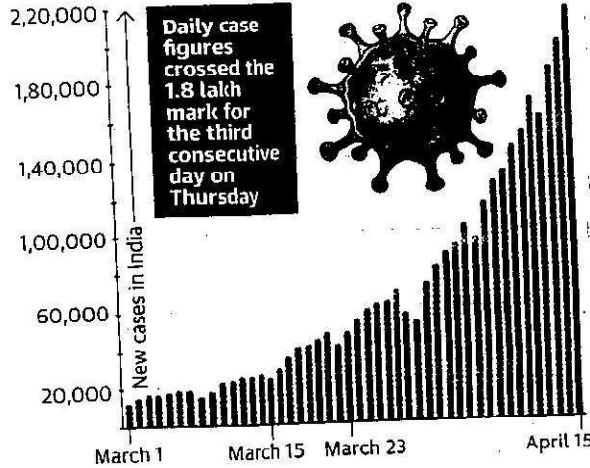
Nearly 33.13 lakh vaccine doses were administered in the 24 hours ending 7 a.m. on Thursday. It is about 6.6 lakh doses more than what was recorded in the previous 24 hours, but 8.2 lakh lower than what was recorded the previous Thursday.

India continues to lead the world in terms of average daily cases. It now accounts for one in four cases reported globally every day.

Mumbai company to manufacture Covaxin

A Mumbai-based company, Haffkine Biopharma Corporation, has received permission from the Centre to manufacture Bharat Biotech's COVID-19 vaccine, Covaxin, on a technology transfer basis.

Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray on Thursday thanked Prime

Minister Narendra Modi for the permission.

The State government sent the proposal to the Centre in February, saying the infrastructure of Haffkine can be used for the vaccine production.

The company has received one-year tenure for the production.
