Former Congress MP Jyotiraditya Scindia, who joined the BJP earlier this year, Congress leader Digvijaya Singh and former Jharkhand Chief Minister Shibu Soren were among those elected to 19 Rajya Sabha seats on Friday. These included 18 seats for which elections were due in March but were deferred due the lockdown.

Of the three seats that went to the polls in Madhya Pradesh, Mr. Scindia and Sumer Singh Solanki, both of the BJP, won with 56 and 55 votes, respectively, according to an official of the Vidhan Sabha. Mr. Singh was re-elected to the Upper House of the 57 votes.

The second preference

Phool Singh Baraiya, secured 36 votes, falling short of the 52-mark to be elected. Two votes were declared invalid. All four seats up for grabs in Andhra Pradesh were won by the ruling YSRCP, taking the party's strength in the Upper House from two to six.

Legislature Secretary and Returning Officer P. Balakrishnamacharyulu said the four victorious candidates, Ayodhya Rami Reddy Alla, Nathwani Parimal, Pilli Sùbhaschandra Bose and Venkataramana Rao Mopidevi polled 38 votes each.

The Telugu Desam Party candidate, Varla Ramaiah, secured 17 votes, he said.
