MLA protests in rain seeking road widening

Kolar: Demanding a long-pending road-widening project be expedited, KGF MLA Roopakala Shashidhar staged a demonstration in the rain on Saturday.

"It's been six years and the road is yet to be widened because the district administration has turned a blind eye," said Roopakala, who protested outside the Kolar deputy commissioner's office.

The 230-metre stretch is located in KGF's Ashoknagar and is the state highway that connects the erstwhile mining town with Tirupati, Vellore and Chennai. The road-widening work began in 2014, but got caught in legal wrangles after owners of some properties moved court. Though the court order favoured road widening, nothing changed on the ground, alleged Ropals lations groups wir vered at the standard orders would be rendered homeless, she claimed.
