Jayanagar MLA Soumya Reddy allegedly hit a woman home guard when her fellow Congress party workers were stopped on their way to the Raj Bhavan on Wednesday.

Footage released by a private news channel showed Soumya petitioned city police Soumya hitting the hand of the home guard. The MLA had been part of the crowd that gathered to protest against farm laws.

As a group of Congresswomen headed towards the Raj Bhavan, police stopped them. Soumya hit the home she fell down. She felt giddy

commissioner Kamal Pant at his office, asking the police to handle women MLAs and others properly during public events.

Speaking to reporters, Soumya said that around 20 police staff pulled her, and

they were making preventive arrests, she said.

"I asked them not to touch me, but they shouted at me and said they are saying this for my own good," Soumya said. "I didn't assault any police. I was only trying to push them when they touched me. They pulled my sari and hair. A male police officer used abusive language at the same time. The commissioner told me these things happen during protests."
