Speaker refers TDP MLAs matter to Ethics Committee

With the TDP MLAs continuing to disrupt the proceedings of the AP Legislative Assembly for the third consecutive day, Speaker Tammineni Sitaram referred the matter to the Ethics Committee to review the behaviour of the opposition members and submit a report on the action to be taken against them. On Wednesday, as soon as the proceedings commenced for the day, the opposition members rushed to the Speaker's podium raising 'Jai Amaravati' slogans. The Speaker took up a short discussion on 'Rythu Bharosa Kendralu'. With the TDP members raising slogans near his podium, the Speaker sought to know whether they will beat him. At one point of time, mild tension prevailed in the House with some of the YSRC leaders rushing into the well after the TDP MLAs raised objectionable slogans against Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy, Intervening, the Chief Minister took strong exception to the attitude of the Opposition members. Accusing the TDP members of making mockery of democracy, Jagan said 10-odd TDP MLAs were making derogatory comments from the Speaker's podium against 151 YSRC members.
