Minister Shivalli no more

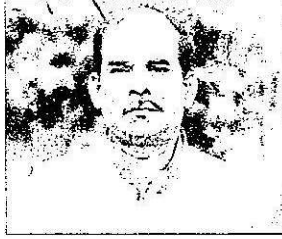
HUBBALLI, DHNS: Municipal Administration Minister and three-time Kundgol MLA C S Shivalli (57) died here on Friday of cardiac arrest.

After Shivalli complained of uneasiness in the afternoon, doctors of the Karnataka Institute of Medical Sciences rushed to his residence at Madani Colony at JP Nagar.

He was shifted to Lifeline Hospital on Gokul Road, as he failed to respond to treatment.

A while later, he died of a massive cardiac arrest. Shivalli was suffering from a heart ailment and diabetes.

Shivalli is survived by wife Kusuma, daughters Roopa,

Deepa and son Amarashiva.

As soon as the news of his death spread, a large number of his admirers gathered at the hospital. The mortal remains were kept at his residence for public viewing till evening. The body was later taken in

a procession to Kundgol, for people to pay tributes till Saturday morning. Shivalli's last rites will be held at his native Yaraguppi on Saturday afternoon. Prime Minister Narendra Modi tweeted condoling his death.

Chief Minister H D Kumaraswamy, his deputy G Parameshwara, KPCC president Dinesh Gundu Rao, former chief minister Siddaramaiah among others are likely to pay their respects on Saturday.

Shivalli became the minister for the first time in December. In 1999 elections, he was elected as an independent. He lost in 1994, 2004 and 2008 elections. But he won in 2014 and 2018 on Congress ticket. He was known for his simplicity and was easily accessible to people.
