However, within minutes, porting criminals involved BJP functionary Amit Malviya posted a video of Deshmukh addressing a press conference

on February 15, seeking to cause the ministers and chief puncture Pawar's claims.

Deshmukh hurriedly issued a clarification saying he had interacted with the media after being discharged from the hospital and en route home for staying in self-isolation.

In the Lok Sabha, Minister of State for Finance Anurag Thakur demanded action against Deshmukh before responding to questions related to his ministry. During Zero Hour, BJP members Manoj Kotak, Girish Bapat, Rakesh Singh and independent member Navneet Rana demanded a Hiran. CBI probe into the allegations levelled by the former police commissioner. Rajya Sabha also witnessed disruptions on the issue.
