Manipur crisis: Four NPP ministers flown to Delhi

AS the BJP has been reduced to a minority in Manipur, four MLAs of ally National People's Party (NPP), who withdrew support to the saffron partyled government last week, were quietly flown to Guwahati by Assam Minister and BJP's troubleshooter Himanta Biswa Sarma.

"They (NPP MLAs) have been taken to Guwahati and subsequently, will be taken to Delhi," a minister in the state told this newspaper.

The four NPP MLAs will meet BJP's central leaders and explain what made them to pull out of the government.



NPP's Manipur chief miffed with CM

The NPP's Manipur leadership is miffed with the CM for his alleged "autocratic" style of functioning. As pressure was being mounted on the party MLAs to return to

The developments came just days after three BJP MLAs resigned from the party and the Assembly and six others four from NPP, one from All India Trinamool Congress (AITC) and an independent MLA _joined Congress which had prompted the grand old party to stake claim.

Earlier on Tuesday, Sarma and Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad Sangma, who is also the NPP president, held closed door meetings with the NPP and the BJP MLAs.
