APMC bill tabled, farmers call for bandh on Sept 28

Bengaluru: Soon after the Karnataka Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation and Development) (Amendment) Bill, 2020 was tabled during the assembly session on Wednesday, protesting pro-farmer organisations called for a statewide bandh on September 28.

Karnataka Rajya Raitha Sangha leader Kodihalli Chandrashekar said, "We thought the state government cared about farmers' welfare but we were wrong. The bill is their way of helping capitalists and corporates at the cost of farmers."

"The assembly has tabled

the bill, ignoring our concerns. We will organise a massive protest on Friday and have called for a bandh next Monday," he added.

On Tuesday, former chief minister Siddaramaiah extended his support to the campaign against the central government's farm bills, saying they will allow the entry of crony capitalism into India.

Siddaramaiah, who attended a 'people's assembly' organised by pro-farmer associations at Freedom Park, said the bills will help the government's 'corporate friends' to buy agricultural land, but will render farmers landless. TNN
