MLAs aged above 70 may get to skip session

Bengaluru: The government is likely to exempt MLAs aged 70 and above from attending the legislature session starting September 21 due to Covid-19 threat, said law and parliamentary affairs minister JC Madhuswamy.

Speaker Vishweshwar Hegde Kageri, Madhuswamy and chief secretary TM Vijay Bhaskar (in pic) on Monday visited the assembly hall and inspected the facili-

ties there to conduct the session. "There is a proposal to give MLAs aged 70 and above the option to skip the session. But a final decision is yet to be taken in this regard," said Madhuswamy.

The session will be held from September 21 to 30. The cabinet which finalised the dates had empowered the speaker and the law and parliamentary affairs minister to decide the venue. TNN
