New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Tuesday asked whether the Maharashtra speaker be put to notice in the contempt proceedings it has initiated against an officer of the state assembly who admitted to have acted on the presiding officer's instructions to warn TV anchor Arnab Goswami of contempt of House proceedings for approaching the SC with a writ petition.

On November 6, Goswami's counsel Harish Salve had drawn the SC's attention to the October 13 letter sent from the office of secretary, Maharashtra Vidhan Sabha Sachivalaya, which was signed by Villas Athawale, assistant secretary, Maharashtra Vidhan Mandal Sachivalaya. Goswami had challenged the breach of privilege notice to him on an MLA's complaint accusing him of dishonourably referring to chief minister Uddhav Thackeray.
