'UK region ignored'

Accusing successive

governments of ignoring the welfare of north Karnataka in terms of irrigation projects, Opposition members from the region in the Legislative Council on Friday urged the government to get awards of tribunals notified to start Upper Krishna Project Phase 3 and Mahadayi project and convene a meeting to discuss mobilisation of funds to complete the projects.

While Leader of the Opposition S.R. Patil said stepmotherly treatment was being meted out to the UKP Phase 3 project that aims to irrigate 14.85 lakh acres across seven north Karnataka districts, senior Janata Dal (Secular) leader Basavaraj Horatti referred to the Mahadayi project that is yet to start.
