Chief Minister says he will resign if BDA scam charged for stringent measures to tackle spread

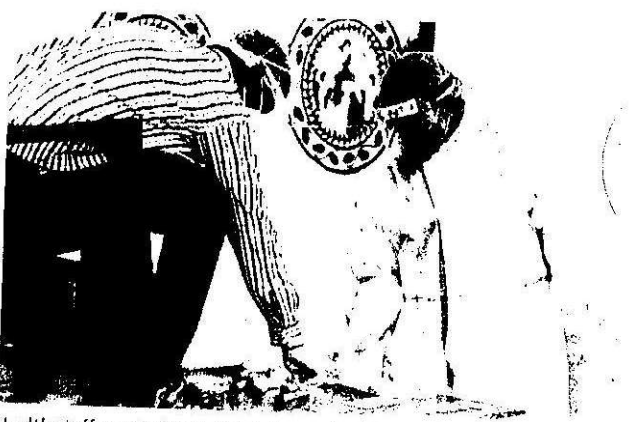
THE no-confidence motion moved by opposition Congress against the BJP government was defeated by a 'voice vote' in the Assembly, even as the debate turned ugly with Chief Minister BS Yediyurappa and Opposition leader Siddaramaiah indulging in a heated, personal duel.

Hitting out at Siddaramaiah, the CM said he will resign if charges levelled by the Congress leader are proved. He said it is Siddaramaiah's responsibility to prove the charges and he can go to the CBI, Lokayukta or the high court. "If the charges are proved, I will resign immediately," Yediyurappa said, irked by Siddaramaiah's allegations against his
