Calling for a "time-bound programme" to address the Maharashtra-Karnataka boundary issue, Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray on Wednesday reiterated the demand of bringing the Marathi-speaking areas on the border under a Union Territory till the Supreme Court gives its verdict.

"Now we have to fight to win...we will have to work in a time-bound programme," Thackeray said in the presence of Maharashtra's top leaders including NCP founder-president Sharad Pawar.



Thackeray was speaking after the release of "Maharashtra-Karnataka Seemavad: Sangharsh Ani Sankalp" (Maharashtra-Karnataka Boundary Dispute: Struggle and Pledge), a book penned by Dr Deepak Pawar.

"If it is not resolved during this government's tenure, it will never be. In Karnataka, whichever government takes charge, it has one thing in common — atrocities against Marathi people," he said.

NCP leader Sharad Pawar said the Supreme Court is the "last resort".
