## Centre notifies Mahadayi Tribunal's final award

DHNS: The Union government notified the Mahadayi Water to utilise 13.42 tmcft water Dispute Tribunal final award on Thursday.

With this, Karnataka's long-standing demand is fulfilled and the state can implement Kalasa-Banduri project to provide drinking water to the parched Hubballi-Dharwad and Belagaviregion.

As per the Interstate Water Dispute Act, the Union Jal Shakthi Ministry issued notification, subject to the outcome of the final verdict of the Supreme Court on the water sharing dispute among Kar-

MEW DELH!/BENGALURU, Phataka, Goa and Maharashtra. This will allow Karnataka from Maḥadayi basin, while Goa and Maharashtra will receive 24 trncft and 1.33 trncft respectively, as per the Tribunal's award on August 14, 2018.

The notification also came a week after the Supreme Court directed the Centre in this regard.

Karnataka plans to build two mini dams across Kalasa and Banduri tributaries in Belagavi district and divert the water to Malaprabha reservoir and utilise it to provide drinking water.
