Cabinet panel on Jindal land

The Cabinet on Friday decided to constitute a sub-committee to review the lease-cum-sale agreement of 2.000.58 acres of government land that was given to the Sajjan Jindal-promoted JSW Steel in Ballari. "It was decided in 2005 to give 2,000.58 acres of government land at Karekuppa village near

Toranagal in Sandur taluk of Ballari to JSW. The Cabinet has authorised the CM to constitute a sub-committee to re-examine this," Law Minister JC Madhuswamy said. The previous Congress-JD(S) coalition had decided to sell the land to Jindal, which the BJP had opposed.
