Report from commission a must for OBC tag, says Siddaramaiah

OPPOSITION leader Siddaramaiah on Saturday said the state government cannot go ahead with its plans on recommending the OBC tag to the Veerashaiva-Lingayat community without seeking a report from the Karnata-

ka State Permanent Backward Classes Commission. The government seems to have not taken the Commission seriously, he said.
