Blow for DKS, court extends custody by ED till Tuesday

Bail Hearing Adjourned To Monday

New Delhi/Bengaluru: In a setback to DK Shivakumar, a Delhi court on Friday extended the senior Congress leader's custodial interrogation by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) till September 17 in a money-laundering case. Hearing on his bail plea has been adjourned to Monday.

The Kanakapura MLA was produced before the special judge at Rouse Avenue Court Complex on Friday evening after the expiry of the ED's nine-day remand. The court directed ED officials to take Shivakumar for medical examination after his counsel Abhishek Manu Singhvi submitted the 57-year-old leader was suffering from high blood pressure

and his health condition was serious. The ED arrested Shivakumar on September 3.

The court asked the agency to ensure the accused takes medicines and meets his doctor, and said he will be examined every 24 hours or as and when required. His family and counsel could meet him for 30 minutes a day.

Additional solicitor general KM Natraj said Shiva-

kumar was “evasive” and gave “irrelevant replies” during interrogation. “Tainted money is Rs 200 crore and there is Rs 800 crore worth of benami property,” he said.

The ASG submitted the ED wanted to confront Shivakumar with certain people and bank documents, while contending his family members and close associates have at least 317 bank ac-

Court rejects PC's surrender petition

A special CBI court on Friday dismissed a plea by senior Congress leader P Chidambaram to surrender in the money-laundering case filed by the Enforcement Directorate. The former minister is currently in Tihar jail in the INX Media corruption case. The ED opposed his plea, arguing that the agency wanted to make use of the 15 days remand it was permitted to seek under the law. **PS**
