THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

COMMON ORDER

R.DEVDAS J., (ORAL):

There are three writ petitions raising common issue and therefore, these writ petitions are clubbed, heard and disposed of by this common order.

2. The petitioners in W.P.No.6001/2020 and W.P.No.8855/2021 are the Staff Nurses working in the Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences (for short, 'MIMS'). The petitioners in W.P.No.5964/2020 are also Staff Nurses, but working in the Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute (for short, 'BMCRI'). However, the grievance in common of all the petitioners is that although by relevant Government Orders issued way back in the years 2006 and 2007, the Government of Karnataka ordered the transfer of the District Hospitals from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges including Mandya and by a separate Government Order, transfer of the Victoria Hospital,

Vanivilas Hospital, Minto Hospital and Bowring Hospital to the BMCRI and which was further bifurcated and part of it attached to the Bowring Hospital thereafter became an autonomous institution, nevertheless, by two separate impugned Government Orders dated 06.06.2017 (in W.P.Nos.6001/2020 and 8855/2021) and 06.06.2017 (in W.P.No.5964/2020, pertain to BMCRI) sought to provide promotion to the Staff Nurses working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare in the MIMS and BMCRI. Obviously, the grievance of the petitioners is that if the impugned orders are given effect to, the petitioners will lose all further promotional avenues as the same will be filled up with the Staff Nurses of the Department of Health and Family Welfare.

3. Learned Counsel Sri. Vijay Kumar V.B., appearing for the petitioners in respect of the matters pertaining to MIMS submits that in terms of the Government Order dated 11.06.2007, the

Government of Karnataka ordered transfer of the District Hospitals from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges at Mandya, Hassan, Belgaum, Shimoga, Raichur and Bidar and brought them under the control of the Department of Medical Education with immediate effect along with transfer of all the infrastructures, buildings & equipments, staff, budget etc. It was also made clear in the Government Order that from the date of the Government Order, all the District Hospitals mentioned therein shall be called as teaching hospitals under the academic, administrative and disciplinary control of the Director/Dean/Principal of the respective Medical Colleges. Further, it is pointed out from the Rules And Regulations-2013 pertaining to MIMS and more particularly, Clause 17, where it is provided that the absorption of the regular teaching and nonteaching staff on deputation from Government and shall be regulated as per the rules framed by the

Learned Counsel submits that when Government. once the staff working in the District Hospitals which were earlier in the Department of Health and Family Welfare stood transferred under the Government Order dated 11.06.2007 to the Department of Medical Education, the State Government, is precluded from promoting the Staff Nurses working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges such as MIMS and BMCRI. The learned Counsel submits while pointing out to paragraph No.13 of the statement of objections filed at the hands of the respondent-State Government that the State Government admits that the MIMS is under the control of the Department of Medical Education. It is also admitted that the Department of Medical Education and Department of Health and Family Welfare are two separate and distinct entities. That being the position, it is impermissible for the State Government to transfer or promote the Staff Nurses working in the

Department of Health and Family Welfare into the Medical Colleges which are under the control of Department of Medical Education.

4. Learned Counsel would also submit having regard to the prayer made in W.P.No.8855/2021, where a writ of mandamus or direction is sought to the Principal Secretary, Medical Education Department to create the required vacancies in the nigher cadre of Nursing Staff in MIMS and to consider the representation dated 16.07.2019, at Annexure-G, within a prescribed time frame, that it would suffice if a direction is issued to the State Government, more particularly, Department of Medical Education to However, learned consider the representation. Counsel would also point out to Annexure-R2 filed along with the statement of objections of the State Government that the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Medical Education has communicated to the Director, MIMS on 20.04.2020 that having

regard to the financial burden or economy measures of the State Government, it would not be possible to permit creation of new posts in the Medical Colleges.

5. Learned Counsel Sri M.R.Shailengra. appearing for the petitioners in W.P.No.5964/2020 pertaining to BMCRI, submits that although the position of the petitioners and the grievance raised are similar to those of the other petitioners, he points out that insofar as the Staff Nurses and other employees working in Victoria Hospital, Vani Vilas Hospital, Minto Hospital and Bowring Hospital, the Hospitals at Vani Vilas and Victoria Hospitals were attached to the Bangalore Medical College much earlier to the action of the State Government in respect of the other Medical Colleges. To that extent, it is submitted that the petitioners who have been working all along in the Victoria Hospital and Vani Vilas Hospital which was attached to the Bangalore Medical College, have a

longer standing when compared to the petitioners in the connected matters.

6. Learned Additional Advocate General Sri R.Subramanya, appearing for the respondent-State submits that although the Government Orders dated 29.12.2006 and 11.06.2007 were issued by the State Government ordering transfer of the District Hospitals from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Department of Medical Education, nevertheless, the lien continued with the Department of Health and Family Welfare. Even as on this day, the lien of all the posts which were created prior to the issuance of the two Government Orders, continues with the Department of Health and Family Welfare. submitted that the petitioners have been appointed to the Medical Colleges and they cannot claim to be Gevernment servants/civil servants appointed to the posts created in the Department of Health and Family Welfare. It is therefore submitted that since the lien

continues with the Department of Health and Family Welfare, the State Government has thought it fit to promote or transfer the present Staff Nurses working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the posts available in the Medical Colleges, including MIMS and BMCRI. Moreover, it is submitted that in terms of Clause 17, which was pointed out by the learned Counsel for the petitioners, the Government is required to frame Rules for the regulation and absorption of the regular teaching and non-teaching staff. Admittedly, no such rules for absorption or Cadre and Recruitment rules are framed in respect of the two Institutions which are the subject matter of these writ petitions. It is therefore submitted by the learned AAG that since the lien of all the posts which were earlier created in the Department of Health and Family Welfare continued to be so, the Government is competent to transfer/promote the Staff Nurses working in the Department of Health and Family

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Welfare to the Medical Colleges including MIMS and BMCRI.

- 7. Learned AAG further submits that since the petitioners in W.P.No.8855/2021 are seeking a direction from this Court to the State Government to create posts and formulate the Cadre and Recruitment Rules, it is a well settled position of law that in such matters of policy, no directions can be issued by this Court. It is submitted that Courts are not permitted to legislate or issue a direction to legislate in a particular manner.
- 8. Sri.P.S Malipatil, learned Counsel appearing for the BMCRI and Smt.Sumana M.Baliga, learned Counsel appearing for the respondent-MIMS submit that the Institution is a Hospital attached to the MIMS and BMCRI, as required under the Regulations of the Medical Council of India. It is submitted that the financial and administrative control of the Institution is in the hands of the Department of Medical Education

and unless the Government permits framing of the Cadre and Recruitment Rules with necessary sanction of the Finance Department, nothing can be done by the Institutions. The learned Counsels would support the submissions of the learned AAG in the matter of continuance of the lien in the Department of Health and Family Welfare.

- 9. Learned Counsel Sri M.P.Srikanth appearing for some of the private respondents who are the Staff Nurses working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare supports the contention of the learned AAG.
- 10. Heard the learned Counsels and perused the petition papers.
- 11. What is evident from the Government Order dated 11.06.2007 is that earlier when Government Order dated 29.12.2006 was issued transferring only the teaching staff from the control of the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Department of the

Medical Education, the Medical Council of India raised objections and stated that it does not meet the requirements of the MCI regulations. Consequently, the Government of Karnataka proceeded to issue dated 11.06.2007 clearly Government Order transferring the District Hospitals along with the infrastructure, buildings, equipments, the budget and the staff already working in the District Hospitals to the Department of Medical Education. It was also clearly stated that henceforth, all such District Hospitals which were stated in the Government Order shall be called as teaching Hospitals under the academic, administrative and disciplinary control of the Director/Dean/Principal of the respective Medical Colleges.

12. What was further required was to formulate the Rules to implement the Government Order including the provision for absorption as contained in Clause 17 of the Rules and Regulations-2013. On the

other hand, the State Government now seeks to contend that although it was directed that all the staff till then working in the Medical Colleges stand transferred from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Department of Medical Education, nevertheless, the lien continues with the Department of Health and Family Welfare. This clearly is trying to blow hot and cold. The Government Orders cannot be treated as mere tools for meeting the requirements of the MCI regulations. Reliance was sought to be placed by the learned AAG on a communication subsequently said to have been made by the Medical Council of India stating that there was no need to permanently transfer the staff and infrastructure from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Department of Medical Education.

13. The submission of the learned AAG to the effect that the petitioners cannot claim to be Government servants/civil servants, since some of

them were subsequently recruited directly by the Medical Colleges, to some extent may be correct, but the grievance of the petitioners is directed towards the impugned Government Orders/actions on the part of the State Government commencing from the year 2017 in trying to transfer/promote the existing Staff Nurses from the Department of Health and Family Welfare into the Medical Colleges viz., MIMS and BMCRI.

14. The grievance of the petitioners is well-founded. If the State Government is permitted to act with impugnity in respect of its own Government orders, then this Court has to step in and hold that such action is illegal and without authority of law. If such action is permitted, it would not only be contrary to the Government Order dated 11.06.2007, but also hoodwinking the petitioners, some of them who were earlier working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare and thereafter stood transferred by

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virtue of the Government orders to the Medical Colleges. Further, if some of the petitioners have been directly recruited to the Medical Colleges, they may not become Government servants/ civil servants, nevertheless, their grievance is against the action of the State Government in trying to bring in the Staff Nurses from the Department of Health and Family Welfare and place them above the petitioners and thereby closing ail avenues of promotion to the petitioners. The contention as to whether some of the petitioners are Government servants or not is not considered in this writ petition. Such question is left open to be decided in an appropriate case.

15. Having regard to all the above aspects, this Court is of the considered opinion that the action of the State Government in trying to transfer/promote the present Staff Nurses from the Department of Health and Family Welfare into the Medical Colleges, more particularly, MIMS and BMCRI is impermissible.

16. Consequently, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. The writ petitions are allowed in part.
- The respondent-State Government is hereby directed not to transfer/promote any of the existing Staff Nurses or any other staff from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges viz., MIMS and BMCRI.
- 3. The State Government, Department of Medical Education, is hereby directed to consider the representation dated 16.07.2019 given by the petitioners in the matter of creation of the required vacancies in the higher cadres of nursing staff and to consider the request of the petitioners for promotion to the higher posts of senior nursing Officers and pass necessary orders as expeditiously as possible and at any rate within a period of three months from the

date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

- 4. The impugned order No.Aa Ku Ka 293 CGM 2016 (Bha-1) dated 06.06.2017 is hereby quashed and set aside to the extent of the State Government trying to transfer/ promote the staff of the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges MIMS and BMCRI.
- 5. In the meanwhile, if some of the private respondents are already transferred to the Medical Colleges at MIMS and BMCRI, necessary orders shall be passed by the State Government to recall such transfers and post such respondents back in the Department of Health and Family Welfare.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending I.As, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for contesting respondent No.5.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that the petitioners are not pressing praver Nos.2 and 3 and insofar as other prayers are concerned, they are covered by the judgment passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court at Bengaluru in W.P.No.6001/2020 and connected matters disposed of

on 19.04.2022, wherein, this Court has allowed the writ petitions in part and directed the State Government not to transfer/promote any of the existing Staff Nurses or any other staff from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges and the State Government has been further directed to consider the representation given by the writ petitioners in the said writ petitions for promotion to the higher posts of senior nursing officers and pass necessary orders expeditiously as possible at any rate within a period of three months. Consequently, the impugned order in the said writ petitions have been quashed to the extent they relates to the transfer/promote any of the existing Staff Nurses or any other staff from the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges and was also heid that in the cases where already transfers were effected, the State Government to recall such transfers in the department of Health and Family Welfare.

- Learned counsel appearing for the contesting respondent No.5 does not dispute the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.
- 4. Under the circumstances, I am of the considered view that even these writ petitions can be disposed of in terms of the order passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court at Bengaluru in W.P.No.6001/2020 and connected matters. Accordingly, following:

ORDER

The writ petitions are disposed of in terms of the order passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court at Bengalur in W.P.No.6001/2020 and connected matters disposed of on 19.04.2022.

Therefore, these writ petitions also require to be disposed of in terms of the order passed in W.P. No.6001/2020 and connected writ petitions disposed of on 19.04.2022. Accordingly, I pass the following:

ORDER

The writ petitions are allowed.



- ii) The respondent-State Government is hereby directed not to transfer/promote any of the existing Staff Nurses or any other staff from the Department of Heal and Family Welfare to the Medical Colleges viz., BIMS, DIMHANS and KIMS.
- iii) The State Government, Department of Medical Education is hereby directed to consider the representation submitted by the petitioners in the matter of creation of the required vacancies in the higher cadres of nursing staff and to consider the request of the petitioners for promotion to the higher posts of senor nursing Officers and pass necessary orders as expeditiously as possible within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- iv) The impugned order dated 06.06.2017 is hereby quashed insofar it relates to State Government transferring/promoting the staff of the Department of Health and Family Welfare to the medical Colleges viz., BIMS, DIMHANS and KIMS.
- v) In the meanwhile, if some of the private respondents are already transferred to the aforesaid Medical

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WP No.147659 of 2020 C/W WP No.147502 of 2020, WP No. 147606 of 2020, WP No. 147778 of 2020

Colleges, necessary orders shall be passed by the State Government to recall such transfers and post such respondents back in the Department of Health and Family Welfare.

In view of disposal of the petitions, pending I.As, if any, do not survive for consideration and the same stands disposed of accordingly.
