Subject :—Supersession of the V. P. Navile in Chikkaikanahalli, taluk, Tumkur District.

No. VPC CR. 60/77-78. (1) A Notice under sub-section (3) of Section 203 of the K.V.Ps. and L.Bs. Act 1959, was issued to the V. P. Navile, Chikkaikanahalli Taluk in VPC CR. 60/77-78 dated 18th June 1977 to show cause within a period of 15 days from the date of service of this notice, why the said V.P. should not be superseded on the grounds mentioned in the notice which were as follows.

- (a) The V.P. has failed to convene its meetings regularly once in a month as required under Section 36 (1) of the Act.
- (b) It has failed to convene sub-committee meetings regularly. The Sub-Committees have not met even once in a year.
- (c) It has failed to take prompt action to collect the arrears of V.P. taxes. Also it has not maintained a correct demand register.
- (d) It has failed to revise the assessment list periodically once in four years as required under K.V.Ps. (Taxes and Fees) Rules 1960.
- (e) It has failed to levy Health, Library and Education Cesses.
- (f) It is reported that as per the audit report for the year 74-75 there is suspected misappropriation of V.P. funds to a tune of Rs. 1047 and the V.P. has failed to take any action to safeguard the interest of the V.P. funds.
- (g) The V.P. has failed to furnish replies to the audit report.
- (h) It has incurred an expenditure of Rs. 200 towards purchase of pulleys for fixing the same to the D.W. wells. But no pulleys have been fixed and no vouchers are forthcoming.
- (i) It is reported that the Chairman of the V.P. has failed to credit the amount of Rs. 100 being the amount stated

to have been realised by sale of manure during the first week of February 1976.

- (j) The V. P. has failed to take up any Developmental work in its villages.
- (k) It is reported that there is no unity among the members of the V.P.
- (l) The V.P. has failed to produce work bills etc., re. the amount spent to the extent of Rs. 1669.20 at the time of inspection by the C.E.O., T.D.B.C.N. Halli.
- (m) The V.P. has failed to discharge its functions as required under section 42 and 43 of the Act.
- 2. This notice was served on the Chairman V.P. Navile on 4th July 1977 and no representation has been received within the stipulated time.
- 3. On a perusal of the connected records and after careful consideration of all the facts of the matter I am satisfied and convinced that the V.P. Navile, Chikkaikanahalli Taluk has become incapable of performing and discharging the statutory duties and other functions as detailed in the show cause notice, which are devolved on it under the K.V.Ps. and L.Bs. Act 1959 and that the working of the V.P. is unsatisfactory.
- 4. Hence in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 203 of the K.V.Ps. and L.Bs. Act 1959, I, G.H. Adirajaiya, Divisional Commissioner, Bangalore Division, Bangalore do hereby declare that the V.P. Navile is incapable of performing the statutory and other duties devolved as it and order that this V.P. be and hereby superseded for a period of one year from 1st October 1977 in the first instance or till the General Elections to V.P. is held and the V.P. is reconstituted whichever is earlier. Further I direct that all the members of the above V.P. shall vacate their office as such members from 1st October 1977.
- 5. Further I also direct the Deputy Commissioner, Tumkur District, Tumkur to appoint an Administrator to exercise all the powers and to perform all the duties of the V.P. Navile, during the period of its supersession as required under Section 203 (3) of the Act.

PREAMBLE:

The Chief conservator of forests has submitted proposals for the release of an area of 30 acres of forest land to the Indian Statistical Institute in S.No. 21 of Kanchenahally and has stated that the tree growth will be handed over to the authorities of Indian Statistical Institute as they wish to utilise the land retaining as much of the verdure as possible except the sandal trees occurring in the area which will have to be protected and maintained by the Indian Statistical Institute as they continue to be the property of State Govt. till they are extracted. The Chief conservator of forests has stated that the assessment will have to be done by the Revenue department as per procedure in vogue.

The Chief conservator of forests has also reported that the total area proposed to be released to the Bangalore University comes to 397.09-0 acres and has requested orders of Government.

Sanction is accorded for the release of 397.09-0 acres as detailed below to the Bangalore University.

Preamble:

The Divisional Commissioner, Bangalore Division has reported in his letter cited above that the village Panchayat Mallathanahalli Group, Bangalore North Taluk has formed six plots for distribution to the landless and houseless agricultural labourers in an extent of 38 acres 21 guntas of land of Mallathanahalli, that only 20 acres 25 guntas of land in S.Nos. 30 and 32 of Mallathanahalli is available as against 64 acres 30 originally proposed for grant to Bangalore University. An area of 94 acres 20 guntas of land in Nagadevanahalli, Bangalore South Taluk comprised in S.Nos. 22, 23, 26, 27, 33 and 34 is also proposed for transfer to Bangalore University, since these proposed for grant are situated within a radius of 16 kms. from the Bangalore City Corporation limits, approval of Government sought for under rule 10(1) of Karnataka Land Grant Rules

O R D E R.

In the circumstances reported by the Divisional Commissioner, Bangalore Division, Government are pleased to accept sanction for grant of an extent of 20 acres 35 guntas of land in S.Nos. 30, 31 and 32 of Mallathanahalli village, Bangalore North Taluk and an extent of 94 acres 20 guntas of land in S.Nos. 26, 27, 33 and 34 in Nagadevanahalli, Bangalore South Taluk subject to payment of cost in favour of the Bangalore University in relaxation of rule 10(3) of the Karnataka Land Grant Rules 1969.

The assignment is subject to the usual conditions set out in the Karnataka Land Grant Rules 1969 in addition to following conditions:-

- i) The lands assigned should be utilised for the purpose for which they have been assigned, failing which the lands shall revert to Government with all the improvements and developments thereon without payment of any compensation what so ever.
- ii) The lands should not be alienated without the permission of the Government. Alienation in favour of any financial agency for raising loans etc., shall be construed as alienation.
- iii) The value of the Malki standing on the land as assessed by the Forest Department will have to be paid to the University Authorities.
