AFFIDAVIT

I, Dr. G.P. Devaraj, aged about 57 years, s/o Sri Puttaiah, working as Joint Director (EDN), office of the Commissioner, Social Welfare Department, M.S. Building, Bengaluru, do hereby solemnly affirm and state on oath as follows:

 I am Respondent No.2 in the above Writ Petition and I am aware of the facts of the case.

2. I humbly submit that as per the direction of this Hon'ble Court, a Report had been submitted on 02.02.2024. After perusing the Report, this Hon'ble Court found that there was overcrowding of the students in the Hostels and directed me to file a Report with regard to the initiative taken by the State Government to accommodate the excess students and Mevent overcrowding.

3. I humbly submit that as per the direction of this Hon'ble Court, I visited Koppal District on 30.08.2024, 31.08.2024, 09.09.2024 and 10.09.2024 along with Deputy Directors and Assistant Directors of Koppal, Kushtagi, Gangavati and Yelburga Taluks, to verify the details of excess admissions in various Hostels. It was found that there were indeed excess admissions in Koppal Taluk and in buildings constructed within the Government Polytechnic premises. Hence, there was a review.

4. Two buildings, which were transferred to the Department of Backward Classes Welfare a year ago and left unused, were inspected upon the orders of the Deputy Commissioner (Revenue) of Koppal. The buildings, including an additional newly constructed building within the college premises, and it was found suitable for accommodation of the students after necessary cleaning, which was done and the buildings were handed over to the Department.

5. To commence these hostels, necessary materials such as kitchen equipment, beds, mattresses, and other essential items were sourced from various taluks of Koppal District where they were previously unused. The following hostels were started:

1. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Government Post-Matric Boys Hostel, Dadagal, Koppal Taluk, Koppal District – 87 students.

2. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Government Post-Matric Boys Hostel, Dadagal, Koppal Taluk, Koppal District - 50 students.

3. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Government Post-Matric Boys Hostel, Dadagal, Koppal Taluk, Koppal District – 50 students.

6. During unexpected visits to 13 hostels in Koppal District, excess students were identified and relocated to vacant buildings constructed within the Government Polytechnic premises, as directed by the Deputy Commissioner, Koppal. Further, requests for funds have been made to maintain the hostels and provide essential basic amenities. Copy of the same is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO-1**.

7. In Kushtagi, Gangavati and Kanakagiri Taluks, students have been accommodated according to the permissible strength in existing buildings and there are no overcrowding issues as reported by the taluk-level officers. Copy of the same is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO-2.** Details of hostels managed by the Social Welfare Department across the state for the academic year 2024-25 are attached herewith and marked as **DOCUMENT NO-3.**

As per Government Order No. Sakai 87 Coordination 2013, dated 20.07.2013, all eligible SC/ST students are granted admission in Hostels managed by the Department. 8. Further, as per Government Order No. Sakai 160 Pkavi 2018, dated 25.08.2018, 25% reservation is provided for Backward Classes and Minority students in pre-matric and postmatric hostels.

From 2024-25, admissions are being managed through the Hostel Management Information System (HMIS) vide Government Order No. Sakai 143 Pkavi 2023, dated 20.12.2023.

Steps Taken for Additional Admissions & Infrastructure:-

9. Due to the increasing number of applications exceeding the approved capacity in post-matric hostels, necessary steps have been taken to ensure that all eligible students are accommodated according to the permissible strength of the hostel buildings.

10. Additional rented buildings have been procured and necessary amenities, including dormitories, kitchens, toilets, and study rooms, have been provided.

Construction of New Hostels & Additional Rooms:-

11. The Social Welfare Department has undertaken the Otal Point Struction of new hostel buildings wherever land is available. Over the past five years, 144 new buildings have been LAKSHMINARAYANA Bengaluru Urban Rep. No. 20363 constructed, and additional rooms and toilets have been built in 235 hostels to manage excess admissions. Copy of the same is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO – 4.**

12. The buildings constructed under the SCP/TSP scheme within Government Polytechnics and Engineering Colleges have been handed over to the Department to accommodate excess students.

Government Polytechnic Colleges to the Department:-

13. The process of transferring 70 hostel buildings constructed under the SCP/TSP scheme by the Social Welfare Department within Government Polytechnics and Engineering Colleges across various districts is currently underway. Once these buildings are officially handed over to the Department, necessary steps are being taken to provide accommodation to students who have sought admission beyond the approved capacity. Copy of the relevant details is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO-5.**

Department of Collegiate Education to the Department:-

14. Instructions have been issued to district-level officers to transfer 55 hostel buildings constructed under the SCP/TSP scheme within government degree college campuses to the Social Welfare Department. These buildings, spread across various Districts, are being taken over and equipped with basic amenities. Following the provision of these amenities, additional students seeking admission are being accommodated. Copy of the same is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO-6.**

Provision of Accommodation and Basic Amenities for Additional Students

15. The Joint/Deputy Directors of the Social Welfare Department in all Districts have been instructed to ensure that there is no overcrowding in Departmental Hostels. For additional students, rented buildings have been procured to provide necessary accommodation. Reports from all Districts confirm that no hostel is overcrowded, and steps have been taken to accommodate extra students using rented facilities. Copy of the supporting data is herewith produced and marked as **DOCUMENT NO – 7.**

16. I humbly submit that the State Government will continue to provide admission to all eligible Scheduled Caste/Category students who apply for accommodation in Departmental Hostels. Information has been collected from all Joint / Deputy Directors of the Social Welfare Department across the State, confirming that all hostels are managing the admissions in accordance with their capacity. Where the number of applications exceeds the approved capacity, additional rented buildings are being used and necessary steps are being taken to provide the required basic amenities as per regulations.
