13th Lok Sabah session held from September 10, 1956, to September 13, 1956; The amendment act was debated in the session, and 'The Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes List (Modification) Order 1956' was adopted considering the Kalelkar Commission report. The commission recommended not to delete the kudubi caste name nor to move to a scheduled tribe or Backward Caste list. The commission recommended including kudubi caste and kudumban caste(both) (s.no. 38 &39) for scheduled caste as in 'The Constitution (Scheduled Caste) Order 1950', for newly constituted Mysore State

Part 08 of 'The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes list (Modification) Order 1956' consists of details of all the communities (Scheduled Castes) relating to Mysore State and in that 8(5) is a list relating to South Canara District. In Serial number 5(27) of this list, Kudumban Tribe is mentioned as a scheduled caste for South Canara district. Further kuduban caste is also categorized as scheduled caste in Kerala and Tamilnadu states and Kudubi Caste name is omitted from the list.

Verification of attached available documents, it is denotes that the caste name of Kuduban included in the scheduled caste and tribe modification order 1956 for the south canara district of Mysore state instead of the Kudubi caste name by typographical error or omitted by oversight. The kalelkar commission copied scheduled castes name including cast name kudubi cast for mysore state from the Madaras state as in in 'The Constitution (Scheduled Caste) Order 1950' list and the commission also recommended the inclusion of 10 other castes for Mysore state.

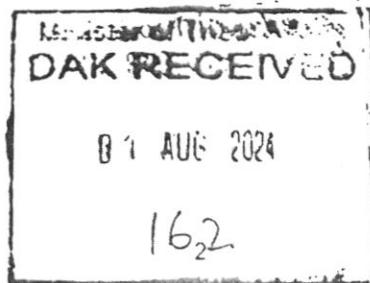
Further, neither the commission recommended deleting kudubi caste name from the list nor moving from the scheduled caste list to the scheduled tribe list nor moving to the list of backward class. Kudubi caste was recognized as a depressed class and primitive tribe as of 1931 and scheduled caste for Madaras province during the British era. Thus the error was a typographical or oversight omission. If the error is typographical or oversight in a constitutional matter then it can be rectified by the central govt itself at parliament.

Further, our request is for rectification or inclusion of omitted and not demand for fresh inclusion of caste name in the scheduled caste list. If the demand for the inclusion of new castes in the scheduled caste list then the recommendation report from the concerned state government is a must.

Respected Sir, My request is to rectify the omission of the kudubi caste(oversight)/correction of the kudumban (typographical error) cast name as kudubi caste name in 'The Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes List (Modification) Order 1956' at the parliament at the earliest and to rectify the injustice done to the Kudubi Community for the last 75 years.

S.R.O. 385.—The following Order made by the President is published for general information:—

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ORDER, 1950.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 341 of the Constitution of India, the President, after consultation with the Governors and Rajpramukhs of the States concerned, is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950.

2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the castes, races or tribes, or parts of, or groups within, castes or tribes, specified in Parts I to XVI of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the States to which those Parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Castes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them in those Parts of that Schedule.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from Hinduism shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste:

Provided that every member of the Ramdasi, Kabirpanthi, Mazhabi or Sikligar caste resident in Punjab or the Patiala and East Punjab States Union shall, in relation to that State, be deemed to be a member of the Scheduled Castes whether he professes the Hindu or the Sikh religion.

4. Any reference in the Schedule to this Order to a district or other territorial division of a State shall be construed as a reference to that district or other territorial division as existing on the 26th January, 1950.
