AGREEMENT made this *twenty third* day of January, 1950, between His Excellency the Governor-General of India and His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore.

WHEREAS it has been decided that the Constitution of India, adopted by the Constituent Assembly of India shall be the Constitution for the State of Mysore as for the other parts of India and shall be enforced as such in accordance with the tenor of its provisions;

AND WHEREAS the Constituent Assembly of Mysore at its Sixth Session has recommended that the rights, privileges and dignities, including the dynastic succession and the privy purse, of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore shall be determined by agreement between him and the Government of India;

IT IS HEREBY agreed as follows:-

ARTICLE I.

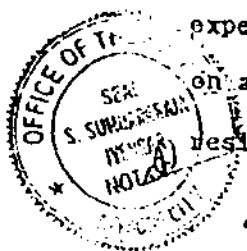
(1) The Maharaja of Mysore shall, with effect from the first day of April, 1950, be entitled to receive annually for his privy purse the sum of Rs. 26,00,000/- (Rupees twenty-six lakhs) free of all taxes;

Provided that the sum specified above shall be payable only to the present Maharaja of Mysore for his lifetime, and not to his successors, for whom provision will be made subsequently by the Government of India.

(2) The said amount is intended to cover all the expenses of the Maharaja and his family including expenses on account of his personal staff, maintenance of his residences, marriages and other ceremonies, etc., and will

neither be increased or reduced for any reason whatsoever.

(3) The said amount shall be payable to the Maharaja in four equal instalments at the beginning of each quarter in advance.

(4) The payment of the said amount as herein provided is guaranteed by the Government of India.

ARTICLE II.

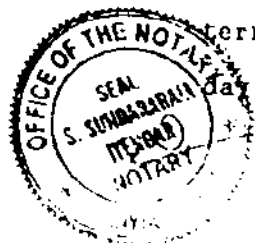
(1) The Maharaja shall be entitled to the full ownership, use and enjoyment of all private properties (as distinct from State properties) belonging to him on the date of this agreement.

(2) The Maharaja will furnish to the Government of India before the *twenty third* day of January, 1950, an inventory of all the immovable property, securities and cash balances held by him as such private property.

(3) If any dispute arises as to whether any item of property is the private property of the Maharaja or State property, it shall be referred to such person as the Government of India may nominate and the decision of that person shall be final and binding on all concerned.

ARTICLE III.

The Maharaja and the members of his family shall be entitled to all the personal privileges, dignities and titles enjoyed by them whether within or outside the territories of the State immediately before the fifteenth day of August 1947.

With reference to Article II of the Agreement between Your Highness and the Government of India, dated 23rd January 1950, and the inventory of the private property furnished by Your Highness in that connection, I write to say that the Government of India, with the concurrence of the Government of Mysore, have accepted as your private property all the items specified in the enclosed inventory.

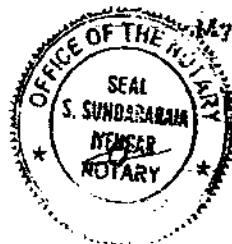
2. The Government of India also recognise all Your Highness' jewellery, including ancestral jewellery and regalia, as Your Highness' private property. The regalia and the jewellery which are used for ceremonial State occasions will be preserved as heirloom of the Ruling family; I am to request that Your Highness may be pleased to furnish to the Government of India, at Your Highness' convenience, a list of these articles for purposes of record.

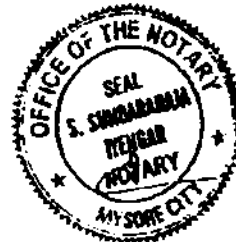

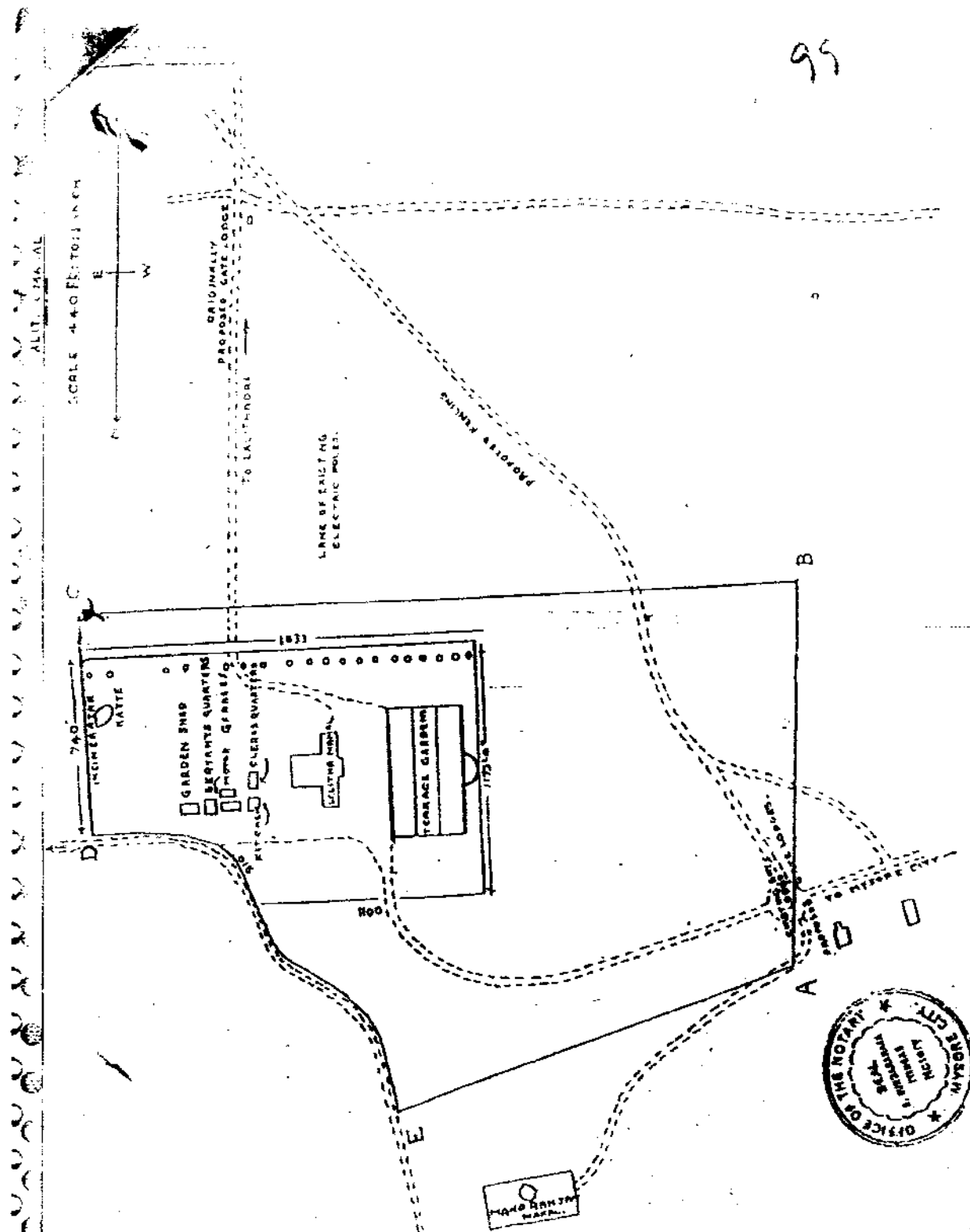

SECTION I.

Immovable properties both landed and buildings
within the Municipal limits of Mysore City and
nearby places.

1. The whole of Kurubarahalli village measuring 1563 acres
31 guntas including the tank and the tank bed area with the
exception of Survey Nos. 1, 2 and 3. There are four public
roads in the area, viz., (1) Kuranji Tank Bund Road (2) Mara-
simaraja Boulevard Road, (3) Chamundi Hill Road and (4)
Chamappaji Urs Road. This has been divided into seven blocks
as noted below for easy identification.

BLOCK NO. 1. This block consists of Kuranji tank and the
tank bed area and the Race Camp Area with the eight cottages
sold to Government, constructed on an area of 21,115 Sq. yards
including the central building where the Sports Club is lo-
cated, the stables, the Pump House and the tank except these
eight cottages constructed on 21,115 sq. yards. This block is
bounded on the East by Chamundi Hill Road, South Narasimaraja
Boulevard Road, West Kuranji Tank bund and North Kuranji Man-
sion grounds and private lands - Survey No. 3 of Kurubarahalli
village - Survey No. 193, 194 of Kyathmanahalli village.

BLOCK NO. 2. Bounded on the North by T.Narasipur Road,
the garden belonging to Mrs. B.P. Krishna Urs, Government land,
burial grounds, thope, Sirdar M.P. Subrahmanyaraj Urs mango
garden, on the East the road running North East commencing from
the main gate of Lalithamahal Palace and joining T.Narasipur
Road, on the South Narasimaraja Boulevard Road and on the West
Chamundi Hill road except buildings and grounds of late Sirdar
Gopalraj Urs, Dalvoys, Sirdar Basappaji Urs, Rajasabhabhushana
Sirdar H. Muddaraj Urs, the two vacant sites belonging to Sri
d.G. Subrahmanyaraj Urs and Lieut. Col. A.C. Subbaraje Urs and
the vacant site of Sirdar D.Devaraj Urs measuring 6,112 sq.
yards, 8750 sq. yards, and 10,743 Sq. yards respectively, and
village site (Gavatana) of Kurubarahalli.

BLOCK NO. 3. Manoranjan Mahal and its grounds, Thope
in its front, bounded by Alnahally lands and T.Narasipur Road
in the East Lalithamahal grounds in the South, approach road
from Kismut corner to T.Narasipur Road to the North comp-
rising also Alanshalli Chathram with temple, pond and compound.

BLOCK NO. 4. Bounded on the east by Lalitha Mahal and
its grounds, on the South Chamundi Hill, on the West Chamundi
Hill Road and on the North Narasimaraja Boulevard Road with
the following buildings:

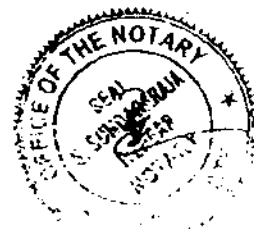

and the vacant side adjoining the Krishnaprasad and survey Nos: 77, 94, 97, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, 120, 122 and 123 of Kurubarhally measuring 74 acres.

BLOCK NO. 5:- His Highness the Maharaja's Body Guards premises bounded on the east by Chamundi Hill Road, on the south Feeder Mala of Karanji Tank, on the west Feeder Mala of Karanji Tank and on the north Marasimharaja Boulevard Road. All the buildings, offices, stables and barracks constructed in this area except the recently constructed 64 family quarters which were constructed out of Government grants.

BLOCK NO. 6:- Survey No. 104 of Kurubarhally Village, 160 acres and 32 guntas, Survey No. 41 of Alnahally Village, 178 acres and 32 guntas totalling to 539 acres and 24 guntas. On this is constructed Lalithamaha Palace.

BLOCK NO. 7:- The area bounded in the east by Chamundi Hill Road, on the south Chamundi Hill, on the west Pimjarapole area and Goblikatte and on the north Municipal Road. This block includes what is known as Red Field, Puttamanni Gardens, Lucerene Garden, Riding School having a Pump House with a well nearby, Mosque Maidan with a Mohamadan Mosque, the Trac Garden, the Mango Thope, the Butt Fire Maidan and Golf grounds.

NOTE.-(1)-

So much of the land on which the Lalitha Mahal is situate together with the outbuildings, roads, gardens and open space as would be necessary for the user of the building as a Guest House will be - demarcated and treated as State property; the rest will continue as the Ruler's property. Sketch enclosed.

(2) The roads at present maintained by the Municipality will vest in the State Municipality.

Maintenance of the roads, electric lighting and other municipal facilities will continue to be provided by the Government or the Municipality as the case may be.

(3) The public will continue to enjoy the present facilities for using the Karanji Tank.

(4) The mosque referred to in Block 7 and the Mosque maidan will be donated to the public by His Highness together with the right of access.

2(a)- The garden and the lands below the Karanj Tank Bund bounded on the east by the Karanj Tank Bund, on the south Municipal Road, on the west the Zoo Garden grounds and on the north by Vasantha Mahal Road. In this block is the Anjanniyaswamy Temple with a quarter to the Archak.

(b)- The area bounded on the east by Daly Avenue Road, on the south Municipal Road leading to Narasimhara Boulevard, on the west Race Course Road and on the north the Lokaranjan Mahal Road consisting of

The Zoo Gardens with its buildings
and animals and the Daly Avenue.

NOTE:- The Zoo gardens with the buildings and animals have been handed over to the State Government for maintenance from out of the allotments for the Government Gardens Department. If at any time the State Government should discontinue the use of the property as a Zoo garden and if it is not proposed to maintain it for some other similar public purpose with the concurrence of His Highness, the property will ~~revert~~ revert to the Ruler.



3. Race Course and Chamundi Gymkhana with all the buildings standing thereon bounded on all sides by the Municipal Roads.

4. The Chamundi Gymkhana Cattle Shed and open grounds attached to it including pump house and pond bounded on the east by Zoo garden road, on the south by the Municipal road, on the west the cross road running between Ittagud and joining the Municipal road in the south and on the north the Municipal road running to the south of the Palace Syces quarters situated in Ittagud opposite to the Zoo gardens-Devaraya Crescent Road.

5. Vasantha Mahal and its compound bounded on all sides by Municipal roads.

6. The buildings known as Erupalaya, Retreat, the Motor Garage Stores, Bloomfield, Rukmalaya, Caladium Villa and Aawath Villa with their compounds.

7. The buildings Dilkush, Jasmin Villa, York Cottage, Shanti Bhavan and Chamundi Cottage with

Palace Garage, the Bank Office buildings and the gardens and grounds bounded on the south by Mirzaroad, on the west by the Zoo garden road running towards Kharbad, on the north by the cross road leading to the Palace Cottages in front of Sri Vani Vilas Ursu Girls' School and on the east by Krupalaya.

10. The Cottage in front of Sri Vani Vilas Ursu Girls' School, viz., the Keet, Rijou Villa and the Palm Cottage and the two types of cottages built for the stables Staff (Nos. 782 to 786 and Coachmen Houses 791, 795, 797 and 799 and the types of cottages for stables officials No. 787 to 790 and the drivers quarters No. 770 to 779 all of them forming into one entire block bounded on the south by the cross road behind Bank Office buildings, on the west by the road in front of Sri Vani Vilas Ursu Girls' School, on the north by the Kharbad Bazaar Road and on the east by Municipal lane, except the intervening municipal lanes in the area

11. Building and the compound where Sri Vani Vilas Ursu Girls' School is situated formerly known as Benson's bungalow bounded by the road leading towards the Zoo to the east, the Kharbad Bazaar Road towards the north, the Mihat Bagh Grounds towards the west and south.

12. The Parks and gardens popularly known as Mihat Bagh with the glass pavilion and the Band Stand bounded by Mirza Road to the south, Government House Road to the west, Shalivahana Road to the north, Sri Vani Vilas Ursu Girls' School and Zoo road to the east.

NOTE:- This property will continue to be open to the public as long as it is maintained as a public park by the State Government from out of the allotments for the State Gardens Department. If the maintenance of the property for such purpose by the State Government is discontinued, the property will revert to the Puler.

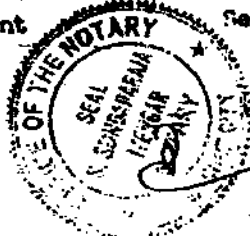

NOTE:- The same remarks noted against Item 12 will also apply to the Central Nursery.

14. Cypress Compound situated in front of the Palace Central Nursery bounded on the north by Mirsa Road, on the east by Park House grounds, on the south by Lokaranjan Mahal road and on the west by Zoo gardens road.

15. The vacant land lying behind Park House compound bounded on the north by Mirsa Road, on the east by Vasanthamahal road, on the south by Lokaranjan Mahal road and Park House grounds on the west.

16. The vacant land and buildings in the area of about 10,000 Sq.Yds., opposite the Zoo - occupied by Palace Stables employees numbering 34 houses bearing Nos.1222 to 1254-1.

NOTE:- These buildings, at present, have been allowed for the residence of certain employees. The use for such purposes will be continued for so long as necessary.

22. The Main Palace:- Palace and other buildings like Khas Bidadri, Quarter Guard etc., and the Temples within the Fort Walls and attached to the Fort Walls and the Gates.

The Mote Maidan on the east bounded in the north by Curzon Park or Hardings Circle, on the east Doddakere Tank Bund Road, on the south the road leading inside the Fort-Jayamarthama Gate and on the west Fort Wall. There is a private temple in this area.
