



78. Managers in the Offices of the Director of Public Instruction and Deputy Director of Public Instruction (Examinations). By promotion from the Cadres of Superintendents in Grade Rs. 180-320 and Stenographers in Grade Rs. 110-320, who have put in at least five years of service in that Cadre and one year's service as 1st Division Clerk on the basis of seniority-cum-merit in the ratio of 7:1, every 8th vacancy being filled in by a Stenographer.

GSR 391A.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 360 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Education Department Services (Department of Public Instruction) (Recruitment) Rules, 1967, namely,—
