



(SCHEDULED CASTES) ORDER, 1950

C.G. 19

NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA,
THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS ASSUMED BY IT UNDER THE
CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, AND IN PURSUANCE OF THE POWERS GRANTED TO IT BY THE
CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ORDER, 1950,

DOES HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the contentances or tribes or parts of, or groups within, tribes mentioned in Schedule VI of the Constitution of India shall, in relation to the State of [REDACTED] and the Union Territories of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.
3. Subject to the provisions of this Order to a State or to a district or other territorial division, the whole or part of which is situated in a State, the Government may by notification declare such division to consist of a Scheduled Caste.

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 20th March, 2015, and is hereby published for general information:—

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ORDERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015

No. 4 OF 2015

[20th March, 2015.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950 to modify the list of Scheduled Castes in the States of Haryana, Karnataka and Odisha and the Constitution (Dadra and Nagar Haveli) Scheduled Castes Order, 1962.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Orders (Amendment) Act, 2015.
