**THE KARNATAKA APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2025
(L.A. Bill No. 80 of 2025)**

(As passed by the Karnataka Legislative Assembly)

A Bill to authorize payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Karnataka for the Services of the Financial year **2025-26**.

Whereas it is expedient to authorize payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services of the Financial year **2025-26**.

Be it enacted by the Karnataka State Legislature in the SEVENTY SIXTH year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. Short Title: This Act may be called the Karnataka Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 2025.

2. Issue of Rupees 627987.33 Lakhs out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Karnataka for the Financial year **2025-26**: From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Karnataka, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 5 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees **Six Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy Nine Crores Eighty Seven Lakhs Thirty Three thousand** towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2025-26 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the schedule.

3. Appropriation:- The sums authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
