I am happy to announce that my Government has already taken a decision to waive the principal and interest amounts on loans taken by individual beneficiaries from the SC/ST/OBC and Minorities Development Corporations as a one-time measure.
- 8. My Government will give equal importance to development sectors along with the social sectors. At one time in the past, Karnataka was a favoured destination for investors. This pride of place has suffered a setback due to political instability and corruption scams. Global recession has also contributed to slow industrial development. My Government is competent to face these challenges. Healthy environment for industrial growth shall be created with a view to increase employment. Essential infrastructure such as land, power, water and other facilities shall be provided in right earnest. Special attention shall be given to protect the interests of the farmers while acquiring lands for industrial purpose. The Infrastructure Policy of 2007 will be reviewed, and the PPP mode of implementation encouraged, in order to create an investorfriendly environment in the State. The Government intends to improve rail connectivity through projects on cost-sharing basis in consultation with the Hon'ble Railway Minister. My

Government will organize the third Global Investors Meet in 2014. It will be the priority of this Government to make all-round efforts to strengthen and rejuvenate the single window clearance mechanism. It is proposed to formulate a new Textile Policy with attractive incentives to textile industries, and make the sector globally competitive.

- 9. We would harness the full potential of Tourism Industry in Karnataka, by upgrading infrastructure and promoting skills and services. My Government accords high priority to the growth of IT and Biotechnology sectors, particularly in tier-2 cities. Karnataka contributes to over one-third of the export earned from these sectors. We revenues in the country, propose to Speed up the establishment of the Information Technology Investment Region (ITIR) for which Government of India has given its 'in-principle' approval. My Government will also focus on the electronics and hardware sector and will of the Karnataka implement the report Information Communication Technology Group, in phases.
- 10. The recommendations made in the Justice Ranganath Mishra Commission and Justice Sachar Committee report for the development and upliftment of religious minorities, especially Muslim minorities who continue to be severely disadvantaged, will be implemented in letter and spirit. This will include promoting and monitoring their access to schools, higher education and health services, encouraging their

participation in MGNREGS, and facilitating their access to bank credit.

- 11. In the backdrop of Kannada receiving classical language status, the proposal for establishment of a Classical Language Research Centre, is under the active consideration of my government. Necessary steps will be taken for the development of regional languages / dialects such as Tulu, Konkani, Kodava, Byari, Lambani, etc.
- 12. My Government is deeply concerned about incidents of abuse and violence against women. We are committed to ensuring that all women, especially vulnerable women, including widows and single women, are enabled to live and work in dignity in environments that are safe and secure. My Government will rigorously implement the two new Central legislations on 'Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012' and the 'Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013' which provide for stringent punishment to persons who commit or abet such offences.
- 13. There is a need to improve the quality of Gender-based budgeting in the State. My Government will make a comprehensive quality review of the schemes incorporated under the Karnataka Mahila Abhivriddhi Yojana (KMAY) and the Gender Budget, and suggest norms and guidelines to ensure holistic integration of the gender and equity

perspective in the formulation of plans and schemes, across all sectors. My Government will also take proactive steps to empower the women's Self Help Groups by enhancing their revolving funds, and providing them with exclusive banking and marketing facilities. The Central Government has approved the restructuring and strengthening of the Integrated Child Development (ICDS) Scheme. We will take full advantage of the revised parameters for improving health, nutrition, immunization and pre-school education of children.

- 14. My Government will endeavour to encourage full and effective participation of persons with disabilities in all facets of society and developmental sectors. We will work towards the progressive removal of barriers in the physical environment, such as public buildings and spaces for work, education and health services, transportation, information and communications technology. Steps will also be taken to provide employment provide employment opportunities to them.
- 15. My Government accords the highest priority to the Education sector, in general, and School Education in particular. We will ensure that all elementary schools conform to the norms and standards prescribed under the Right to Education Act, including availability of adequate teachers, classrooms, barrier-free access, drinking water and separate toilets for boys and girls. Schools shall be revamped based on student-teacher ratio. Government is committed to provide quality

education to all children in the State. No Government school will be closed based on flimsy reasons. Focus will be on enhancing the quality of teaching to make learning more activity-based, child-centered and child-friendly. Government Schools will be provided facilities for games and sports and children will be encouraged to nurture school gardens. We will also move towards an eight year elementary education cycle, in keeping with the provisions of the RTE Act. Teacher Eligibility Tests will be conducted annually to facilitate regularity in recruitment against retirement vacancies. Well trained Kannada teachers will be provided in Minority Institutions. Re-deployment of teachers will be given priority so that, subject teachers are available in the prescribed pupilteacher ratio in every school. We will intensify our mobilization efforts to promote literacy among women and other disadvantaged groups.

16. The quality of higher education has suffered on account of large number of faculty vacancies in universities, colleges and polytechnics. My Government will make a determined bid to fill all these vacancies. It will be the priority of my Government to improve the employability and skill development in order to ensure suitable job opportunities for all. With the active support of industry and employers, adequate resources will be reserved for upgradation of infrastructure of training institutions as well as expansion of

- their jurisdiction to provide need based skill-development and training.
- 17. The poor are particularly vulnerable to the lack of health security MY Government will focus on improvement in access and availability of quality health care for all. Affirmative action will be taken to address regional disparities in health care. We will improve the access of BPL families and senior citizens requiring hospitalization in identified specialty services through a network of health-care providers. Steps would be taken to ensure fair access, besides timely and adequate availability of quality drugs. All the existing health insurance schemes shall be reviewed to bring them under a single comprehensive umbrella scheme. My Government Welcomes the establishment of the National Urban Health Mission and will take all steps to expeditiously implement the programme.
- 18. Growing urbanization has led to an acute gap between the demand and supply of housing units for the weaker sections and the SC/ST/Minority population. MY Government will revisit the Karnataka Housing and Habitat Policy, 2009 to provide a time-frame for fulfilling its objective of 'Affordable Housing for Al1'. My Government has increased the unit cost of houses for the poor to Rs. 1.50 lakh in villages and Rs.2.00 lakh in urban areas, While the subsidy amount for each house has been enhanced from Rs. 75,000 to Rs 1.20 lakh. We will set up a Centralized Data Centre to monitor the achievement

of physical and financial targets across the multiple Implementing Agencies involved in providing housing in the State and make Karnataka 'hut-free'. We will take full advantage of the Rajiv Awas Yojana to make the State, 'slumfree'.

- 19. We will give the highest priority to revamping and streamlining the public distribution system. My Government has already decided to distribute rice at Re.1/- per Kg upto 30 Kg per family having BPL card, with effect from 1" July, 2013.
- My government will work towards restoring the well-being 20. and dignity of farmers who have faced severe drought in recent times. We will make determined efforts to make agriculture more scientific and remunerative to effectively halt the migration of farmers to the cities. My Government will also set up Agriculture Price Commission to ensure that farmers get a remunerative price for their produce. The productivity of crops will be enhanced across the spectrum, to compensate for the continual diversion of agricultural lands. Bhoochetana scheme will be broad-based to secure the livelihood of the marginal farmers. The expertise of International Institutions will be harnessed to create an extension service ir1 the private sector which will provide a good entrepreneurial opening for agriculture graduates, besides enhancing farm productivity. The watershed schemes

- ir1 the State will be enlarged in coverage to drought proof all dry lands, in a time-bound manner.
- 21. Karnataka is endowed with diverse agro-climatic zones suited for a variety of horticulture crops. Although farmers use just 15% land for horticultural crops, yet we generate 40% of the agricultural income from horticultural produce alone. In order to promote exports and value addition, we propose to link horticulture farmers to agri-business in the country and abroad by setting up high-tech clusters. The entire set-up of horticulture marketing would be re-vamped to make it more responsive to the needs of the farmer.
- 22. Karnataka is a major milk producer. Animal husbandry is no longer a tertiary occupation in the State, but an effective weapon in "drought-proofing" dry lands. My Government has increased the subsidy to milk producers from Rs.2 to Rs.4 per litre, a move that will benefit 45 lakh farmers. My Government will modernize the fisheries college in Mangalore and the veterinary universities in the State, to make the animal husbandry sector effectively complement agriculture and horticulture.
- 23. My Government is committed to protect our forests and natural resources. For this, the Forest Department will use state of art technology to fix boundaries, prevent encroachments and detect poaching and fires. Encouragement will be given to farmers to grow more trees in their lands.

- 24. My Government is committed to strengthening and empowering the Gram Sabhas. We will make all efforts to ensure that the selections made by the Gram Sabhas are respected at all levels of implementation. My Government is committed to amend the Act to ensure that the Adhyakshas or Members of Gram Panchayaths who come in the way of implementing the core functions of Panchayath Raj Institutions, are disqualified. In keeping with the 73" Constitutional Amendment, we will move towards increasing the share of District Sector schemes in the Budget.
- 25. Karnataka has the second largest drought prone area in the country. My Government is committed to utilise MGNREGS as a powerful weapon to provide succour to the poor, drought affected rural populace, in a transparent and effective manner. MGNREGS is the biggest social safety net programme. It is a rights-based programme for the economic empowerment of rural poor, with equal wages for men and women. It will be of my Government endeavour to improve implementation of the programme, by enhancing number of person days, ensuring timely payment of wages and undertaking Systematic social audit. My Government will expeditiously set up the Rural Livelihoods Mission to extend the benefits to the needy and poor, with special focus on empowering and organising women.
- 26. My Government is committed to providing safe drinking water to the rural areas on par with urban areas. There are

- 5875 villages affected by fluoride, Arsenic and Nitrate, besides other chemical contaminations. The Model 'Pure Drinking Water Unit', as installed in Gadag, will be provided in all problematic villages. 1000 such units will be commissioned by 1st January, 2014. We are indeed indebted to Government of India for allocating 1400 crores for this purpose in the 2013-14 budget.
- 27. My Government aims to take up a drive to provide healthy and hygienic environment in the villages. Accordingly, 60 lakh individual toilets will be constructed with assistance provided by Government of India under Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan. Similarly, the quality of roads shall be imporved by effective implementation of Prime Minister's Gram Sadak Yojane.
- 28. Our priority will be to complete 78 lingering irrigation projects in the State. We will take steps for inclusion of the upper Bhadra project as a National Project to serve drought prone districts of Chitradurga, Tumkur, Shimoga and Chikmagalur. We are committed to provide drinking water to Kolar, Chikkaballapur and Tumkur by filling up the tanks from the irrigation projects. In this direction, we will take up Yettinhole project and Will also seek Central Assistance for the same. The scientific evaluation of other schemes will be expeditiously completed. Civil works under Upper Krishna Phase Ill Project would be started on the ground, on priority to utilize 177 TMC water awarded by Krishna Waters Tribunal.

The long- pending extension, renovation and modernisation projects of the Cauvery basin will be taken up for approval of the Government of India, in conformity with the Cauvery Award. To increase irrigation efficiencies, my Government will take up new micro-irrigation projects in command area. The scientific evaluation of other schemes will be expeditiously completed. My Government also accords importance to minor irrigation works especially rejuvenation of tanks in drought prone areas, Action will be taken to prevent Over exploitation of ground Water and to improve the ground water regime as visualised in the Karnataka Ground Water (Regulation &, Control of Development and Management) Act, 2011.

- 29. My Government attaches highest priority to the power sector. Sincere efforts will be made to enhance the power generation capacity and complete all pending projects expeditiously. Simultaneously, we will reduce the distribution losses. My Government will also make serious efforts for obtaining clearances of power projects held up on account of unresolved coal- linkages and environmental issues. We will promote clean and green energy through a Renewable Energy Policy, thus promoting the use of solar pumps and equipment.
- 30. It is proposed to revamp the Public Works Department to ensure greater transparency and efficiency in the execution of works. The up-gradation of State and National Highways and Major District Roads (MDRs) will be given priority. Steps

- would be taken to implement an effective and comprehensive Sand Mining Policy.
- 31. My Government is also committed to strengthen and expand the reach of minimum wages, safe work places and the social security pillars of health, insurance, pension, maternity benefit and employees' compensation, for all workers in the informal sector.
- 32. The urban population, which stands at 38% today, has been growing rapidly in the State; but the development of infrastructure has not kept pace with this growth. Therefore, Master Plans for providing underground sewerage, solid waste managemgm, housing and drinking water etc, in all urban areas will be prepared on top-priority, Development of Bengaluru would be focused through proper co-ordination between all service providers such as BBMP, BWSSB, Transport, Power Housing, and Corporations. My Government is committed to the completion of Metro Phase-I and will take up Phase-II, immediately thereafter.
- 33. The Parliament has inserted the Article 371(i) in the Constitution of India for according special status to six backward districts -Gulbarga, Yadgir, Raichur, Bidar, Koppal and Bellary in the Hyderabad-Karnataka region. My Government will formulate necessary regulations within three months for establishing a separate development board, ensuring equitable allocations of funds, and providing

- requisite reservation in employment and education for reducing inter-regional and inter-district disparity and promoting inclusive growth.
- 34. My Government is committed to strengthening the Revenue Administration to provide time-bound services to the people at their door steps. My Government attaches great importance to the efficient disbursal of Social Security Pensions to the vulnerable, elderly and physically challenged people. A High Powered Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary will be constituted to study the recommendations given by Shri A.T. Ramaswamy and Shri Balasubramaniarn Committee and submit a report. Stringent action shall be taken against those who encroach and/or abet encroachment of Government lands. Government will prepare a Land Policy and introduce a system of land audit for Government lands given on grant or lease.
- 35. In building a prosperous Karnataka, my Government is determined to provide a clean, stable, transparent, people-friendly and corruption-free administration. A Centre for Good Governance and Innovation will be established to spearhead administrative reforms. The system of computerized counselling will be extended across departments for fair and transparent transfers of officials. A specific Policy on Transfer of Government servants has been formulated. Recruitment, promotions, transfer and other service benefits shall be based on eligibility and performance only. There

would be no room for prejudice or vengeance Government servants should also become accountable to people for performing their duties Without fail. My Government believes that this will be a big step in achieving administrative efficiency. E-Governance initiatives such as mobile governance, e-district, e-procurement and citizen service centres shall be promoted throughout the State. Second generation reforms would be introduced to bring in qualitative improvements to Sakala Services Act- 201 1, to make all Government service deliveries hassle-free and time bound.

- 36. Karnataka has adhered to the statutory ceilings for key fiscal and debt indicators. My Government by curtailing wasteful spending effective targeting of subsidies and focusing on growth inducing capital investment. In this regard, my Government will implement the recommendations of the Expenditure Reforms Commission in a time bound manner. My Government will make tax administration more effective and efficient and will exhibit zero~tolerance to tax evasion in all its forms. I trust that these reform measures will enable us as a State to fulfill the aspirations and hopes and justify the faith that people have reposed in us.
- 37. I seek your co-operation in realizing our collective goal of making Karnataka a model for other States and countries to follow. I hope that both the houses will see meaningful and constructive debate for the passage of progressive legislations in the days to come, so that we can fulfill the expectations of

the people. I wish you all, every success in achieving this ambitious endeavour.
