Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat (Recruitment & Conditions) Service Rules 2003, which the Special Board of Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of the section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) were published as required by clause (a) of Sub section (2) of the section in Notification 3 of the said act for the NO.KLCS/ADM-1/38/C&R/2017, Bangalore, dated:06.02.2021 in Part IV-A, No.177, of the Karnataka Gazette, Extra-ordinary dated:06.02.2021, inviting objections and suggestions from persons likely to be affected thereby within 15 days from the date of its publication;

Whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 6th February 2021.

Whereas the no any objections and suggestions received.

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of the section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990)

read with the second proviso to the said sub-section, the Special Board of the Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat hereby makes the following rules. Viz,

RULES

- 1) Title and commencement: - These Rules may be called **Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat (Recruitment and conditions of service) (Tenth Amendment) Rules, 2020.**
- 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.
- 3) **Amendment of Schedule-I :-**
 1. In the Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat (Recruitment and conditions of service) Rules 2003 in Schedule-I in the entries relating to the category of **post of Secretary at Sl.No.1, in Col.No.5** clause a) for the words "**Joint Secretary**" the words "**Additional Secretary**" shall be substituted.
 2. In the Karnataka Legislative Council Secretariat (Recruitment and conditions of service) Rules 2003 in Schedule I in the entries relating to the category of **post of Secretary at Sl.No.1, in Col.No.6** clause C) for the words "**Joint Secretary**" the words "**Additional Secretary**" shall be substituted.
 3. The following entries shall be substituted at **Sl.No.2** for the upgraded post of Joint Secretary as Additional Secretary.

For Deputation: Must have put in a service of not less than four years as District Judge.
